Halifax Civic Workers Association Local 108 were founded on November 20, 1941. Halifax Civic Workers are outside Workers Employed by Halifax Regional Municipality. There are over 400 members in this Unit which include; Labourers, Facility Maintainers, Gardeners, Utility Workers, Storepersons, Traffic Sign & Marking Technicians, Cemetary Attendants, Painters, Plant Operators including Arena, Rink, Pool and Engine Room Operators, Chief Plant Operators, Building Trades Persons, and Fleet Trades Persons.
