Note

Dr. Oxorn was born in 1920, graduated from Dalhousie Medical School in 1945, and completed post-graduate studies at Yale and McGill University. He was on staff at McGill University and at the Royal Victoria Hospital in the Department of Obstetrics and Gynaecology.

In 1972, Dr. Oxorn moved from Montreal to Ottawa to join the University of Ottawa as Professor of Obstetrics and Gynaecology. In addition, he accepted a clinical appointment at the Ottawa Civic Hospital. He authored several books and was an active member in professional associations.

Dr. Oxorn retired in 1995 and currently resides in Quebec.
