 arms I am here with my two hands
 that is my safety razor and the
 pencil from you and Gilbert's. I hope
 I would like to have one like that
 to use for this evening. I hear you
 that the schools are all closed in
 California an account of the flu
 well I do hope that you will not
 get that stuff take good care and
 not get around where it is as it
 is bad stuff I expect that you
 are having a good time no school
 just have all time to your self
 I expect to be hot home with you soon
