Dear Mrs. MacMechan.

Thanks for your note of the 13th. At the present time I am hard at work on a novel, begun last summer and promised to my publishers for May lat. For this reason I shall not be in the city before that date. Beyond that I cannot say except that I home to be in Halifax on or about May 15th with my novel finished and my mind clear of it. This isn't very satisfactory, I know, but it's the best I can do at the present.

With regard to the proposed omnibus volume. I haven't made a positive selection and will not have one until I have talked it over with one or two friends in Helifax who are staumen admirers of your husband's work and whose ideas I want to weigh against my own. This will be in May. The space available in a single volume requires a very rigid selection and we shall have to leave out much that was admirable. I ask myself this question — " Of all Doctor MacMachan's work, what is most valuable to the present generation and the generations to come?" And my own strong impression is that his tales of the sea are the enswer. They have a double value, for they are history as well as literature. He alone, of all Canadian writers of his time, saw that the story of the saling ships and their men — and women — was passing before his eyes and would soon be gone, and you know how carnestly he strove to catch that story not only with words but in his collection of ship models and pointings.

With this in mind. I have a tentative selection as follows: from THRRE GO THE SHIPS - "A Deacon Light", "The Great Ship", "A Vision of the Night", "The Shell", "The Saptain to Wife", "The Wave", "Jury Blg", "Down Immenture Way"

From OLD PROVINCE TALES -- "Godfrey of the Rover", "The Saladin Pirates", "The Sarah Stands By", "Rudder Churchill".






