Dear Sir:

I am informed that this seaman died in England survived by a widow and one daughter who lives out here. The widow left England and came to Canada and died here last year leaving a fairly large estate. The daughter's right to the estate is held up until it is proved that her father, Harry Croker, and her mother were married. The marriage took place in England some time between 1904 and 1922.

I am enclosing herewith a copy of the Merchant Marine in which her father served from the years 1909 until 1925. This book belonging to her father was put in evidence, but I do not consider it sufficient.

Would you please be so kind as to have someone look up the articles signed by Croker each time he signed on, and advise me if he made any notice of allotment of his wages and to whom he made them payable, and the address of the payee. This, I believe, would be very helpful evidence for proof of his marriage to Mrs. Croker and if you would please be so kind as to certify your statement under your own seal it will be of material assistance to this daughter.
