Dear Dr. Thomas

The International Ocean Institute takes pleasure in inviting you to attend Pacem in Maribus V, to be held in Malta from September 9 through 13, 1974.

As during the past four Convocations, we shall have the participation of distinguished statesmen and legal experts, industrialists, fishery experts, ocean scientists, ecologists, and students and junior civil servants, with a maximum interaction among these groups.

The Convocation will be presided over by H.E. Mr. H. Shirley Amerasinghe of the Republic of Sri Lanka who, as you know, is President of the U.N. Conference on the Law of the Sea. Sir Anthony Mamo, Governor-General of Malta, will be the Honorary Chairman. The inauguration will take place on September 9 at 8:00 p.m. at the Corinthia Palace Hotel.

The Convocation will deal with two major topics:

1. An assessment of the results of the Caracas session of the U.N. Conference on the Law of the Sea, with special emphasis on
 - a. The implications of the Economic Zone concept for the development of an international ocean regime, and
 - b. The prospects for arms control and disarmament in the oceans. This topic will be introduced by Mrs. Alva Myrdal of Sweden on the afternoon of September 13. Her presentation will be followed by a report by Dr. N. K. Panikkar of India on the Indian Ocean as a Zone of Peace, and by general discussion.
2. The development of the living resources of the Mediterranean. This topic will be introduced by Dr. Sidney Holt, Director of the IOI.



Thank you for your letter of 7 November and for the information about your energy project.

In fact, I have been in touch with Elisabeth Mann Borgese about this and you will see that we published a short news item in the first issue (page 84 of the enclosed copy).

Miss Borgese has already agreed to report the conference for us.

From the provisional conference programme, it is obvious that there will be a strong emphasis on the developing countries. I feel that it would be very important to have this emphasis reflected in the report. The Third World is all too often forgotten in global discussion on energy.

Perhaps the two main questions will be:

- how will these countries cope with rapidly rising oil prices?
- how will their energy consumption patterns develop; along lines similar to the industrialised nations, or will they learn by the mistakes of others?

Could you liaise with Miss Borgese about the report?

Unfortunately, our deadline for the March 1974 issue is 18 December, which will probably be too soon for you: the next issue would be published in June. Please say whether it would be possible for you to meet the March deadline.

Dear Miss Borgese,

Please excuse my silence since your letter of 6th April. This certainly has not been because of a lack of interest in your energy = study project, but rather the pressure of work involved in launching ENERGY POLICY.

The first issue will be published in ten day's time and we will send you a copy. It contains a news item on the structure and aims of your project.

I note that the preparatory conference will have taken place on 7 - 9 June and I am writing, specifically, to enquire about the possibility of publishing information about the conference in ENERGY POLICY.

This could take various forms - from a conventional summary of the proceedings and conclusions through to publication of some of the papers presented, if appropriate.

We would wish to publish at least a summary in the second issue of ENERGY POLICY to follow on from our news item. Would you have the time and would you be prepared to write a review of the conference by 13 July? I suggest about 2000 words and a fee of £25 payable on publication.

More generally, I would like very much to see copies of the papers prepared for the conference, if this is possible. We would, of course, be happy to reimburse you for any copying and postal costs.

I commend your initiative on organising this project and we will try to help you in publicising its results. Would your plans to publish the papers in book form preclude prior publication of some of the papers - perhaps in a shortened form - in ENERGY POLICY?

This would be a way of making sure that the information was circulated widely and would also act as promotion for the book.


If there are any other ways in which we might be able to assist, please say.

Your letter of 7th January was very interesting. This is a hasty preliminary reply.



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
