

THIS AGREEMENT made this day of
1968,

BETWEEN:

THE GOVERNORS OF DALHOUSIE COLLEGE AND
UNIVERSITY, a body corporate, at Halifax,
in the County of Halifax, Province of
Nova Scotia, hereinafter called the
"GOVERNORS",

OF THE ONE PART

- and -

HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN, represented by
the Department of the Secretary of State
of Canada, hereinafter called the
"DEPARTMENT",

OF THE OTHER PART

WHEREAS the National Museum of Canada is administered
by the Department;

AND WHEREAS the Governors recognize the services
which can be provided by the National Museum of Canada in preserv-
ing animal specimens of national importance;

WITNESSETH that in consideration of the promises made
by the parties hereto it is covenanted and agreed between them
as follows:

1. The Governors will deliver to the National Museum of
Canada located at Ottawa, Ontario, the specimen Labrador duck,
owned by the Governors, on a loan basis;
2. The Department agrees that the National Museum of
Canada will preserve the specimen Labrador duck and return it,
on request, to the Governors in the same condition in which it
was received;
3. The Department agrees to compensate the Governors for
any damages to the Labrador duck while on loan to the National
Museum of Canada;
