THIS AGREEMENT made this day of

1968,

BETWEEN:

THE GOVERNORS OF DALHOUSIE COLLEGE AND UNIVERSITY, a body corporate, at Halifax, in the County of Halifax, Province of Nova Scotia, hereinafter called the "GOVERNORS",

OF THE ONE PART

- and -

HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN, represented by the Department of the Secretary of State of Canada, hereinafter called the "DEPARTMENT",

OF THE OTHER PART

WHEREAS the National Museum of Canada is administered by the Department;

AND WHEREAS the Governors recognize the services which can be provided by the National Museum of Canada in preserving animal specimens of national importance;

WITNESSETH that in consideration of the promises made by the parties hereto it is covenanted and agreed between them as follows:

1. The Governors will deliver to the National Museum of Canada located at Ottawa, Ontario, the specimen Labrador duck, owned by the Governors, on a loan basis;

2. The Department agrees that the National Museum of Canada will preserve the specimen Labrador duck and return it, on request, to the Governors in the same condition in which it was received;

The Department agrees to compensate the Governors for 3. any damages to the Labrador duck while on loan to the National Museum of Canada;

4. The Department agrees to be responsible for all costs of the care, storage and upkeep of the Labrador duck while at the National Museum of Canada and also the cost of returning the Labrador duck to the Governors upon request.

THIS AGREEMENT shall enure to the benefit of and be binding upon the parties hereto, their successors and assigns respectively.
