1600 Dalhousie Grads

At six convocation ceremonies this spring, Dalhousie graduated about 1600 students. Among the graduates were over 1100 who qualified on the Bachelors level, 200 Masters, about 24 Doctorates, including 13 who received honorary Doctor of Laws degrees, 90 Medical Doctors, 25 Dental Doctors and over 100 diploma and certificate recipients.

Degrees were not the only things awarded at convocation: This spring over 70 prizes were awarded recognizing various accomplishments and contributions made by the graduates. Besides the University, the Dalhousie Student Union recognized students contributions to the Dalhousie community in the form of Gold and Silver D's, as well as the highly prized Malcolm Honour Award.

Three outstanding graduates received the top university awards. **Donald Lorne Whiteway** was awarded the Governor General's Gold Medal, awarded to the leading First Class Honours graduate of the year.

Lorne received the degree of Bachelor of Science with First Class Honours. Lorne plans to further his studies in mathematics, preferably at Harvard (where he has been accepted already) or Oxford University in England. He is the son of Dr. Stirling Whiteway, B.Sc. '47, M.Sc. '49, and Mrs. Whiteway of Dartmouth.

Nasrin Rahimieh was the recipient of the University Silver Medal which is awarded to the student who is judged to be the leading First Class Honours graduate of the year in either Arts or Science in whichever field the Governor-General's Gold Medal was not presented. Nasrin, a past recipient of the Women's Division Silver Medal in French, received a Bachelor of Arts with First Class Honours in French and German, and plans to further her French studies at Dalhousie.

Bonny Linda Lee of Halifax received the Avery Prize which is presented to the student with the highest standing in a general course. Bonny received her B.Sc. with a major in chemistry. Also a recipient of a Women's Divi-

sion prize, Bonny will continue her studies in the fall at Dalhousie's School of Medicine. She is the daughter of Fred and Miranda Lee of Halifax.

The University also presented 15 graduates with medals. A University Medal in the Faculty of Administrative Studies was awarded to **Susan Beth Rubin** from Moncton, who graduated with a Bachelor of Commerce degree.

In the Faculty of Dentistry, **Greg Arthur Burk** from Saint John, N.B. received a medal.

Rani Hajela from Halifax, graduated from the School of Nursing, and **Dianne Elizabeth Archer**, a native of Hampton, N.B., graduated from the College of Pharmacy, both received University Medals in the Faculty of Health Professions.

In the Faculty of Arts and Science, there were 11 recipients of University Medals. **Sylvia Jayne Craig**, Halifax, was the top graduate in Biology.

In Chemistry, the recipient was **Main Chiong Yee**, Halifax; in Economics, **Michael Terrence Shannon**, Dartmouth; in Engineering-Physics, **Robert Bell Merritt**, Halifax; English, **David Michael Sullivan**, Halifax; French, **Nasrin Rahimieh**, Halifax; Mathematics (the Sir William Young Gold Medal), **Donald Lorne Whiteway**, Dartmouth; Philosophy, **Barbara Joan Harvie**, Enfield; Physics, **Mark Allan Walton**, Fredericton, N.B.; Psychology, **Jane Dorothy Grantmyre**, Halifax, and in Russian, **Neil Colin Chambers**, Halifax.

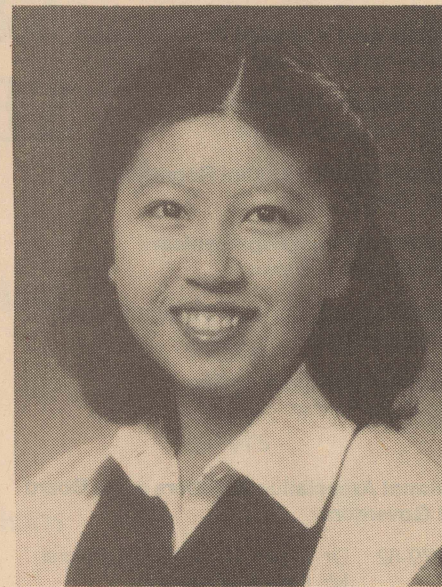

1981 Learned Societies Conference at Dalhousie University

From May 20 until June 6 the Learned Societies of Canada were hosted by Dalhousie University in Halifax. Every year the Conference takes place in a different University in the country, carefully following a pattern of shifting from the centre of Canada to the East and again to the centre and then to the West, and so forth. Recently, the Learned Societies Conferences have taken, and will, take place in:

- 1978, London, Ontario, University of Western Ontario;
- 1979, Saskatoon, Saskatchewan, University of Saskatchewan;
- 1980, Montréal, Québec, Université de Québec à Montréal;
- 1981, Halifax, Nova Scotia, Dalhousie University;
- 1982, Ottawa, Ontario, University of Ottawa;
- 1983, Vancouver, British Columbia, University of B.C.

Hosting the Conference is a rare opportunity and great challenge for the host university. About 5,000 to 6,000 delegates will attend the meetings of over 65 societies, giving a university a unique opportunity to open its doors to scholars from all across Canada and to let them experience the campus, faculty, facilities and the particular intellectual climate a university always offers its guests.

From May 20 to June 6, about 5,500 visitors attended the 64-society gathering at Dalhousie. For most of these 18 days the weather was friendly and encouraged delegates to explore Halifax and enjoy the seaside.

What went on during the Conference? This question is most difficult to answer because of the diversity of the programmes of the 64 participating societies. Some societies' pro-

grammes contained more than one hundred sessions, lectures or workshops, while other societies just met and discussed, quite informally, a few topics of special interest or concern. If just one day's programme of the Conference was analysed one would be impressed by the varied and numerous topics which were discussed and debated during the Conference. The topics dealt with on that one day ranged from political to biblical to sociological and elusive mathematical concerns, that were interesting, stimulating and at times astounding. For example, there was one paper presented on an "Immodest Lady Wrestler in Dexteronomy XXV 11-12" and a very up-to-date discussion pursued on "Constitutional Reason of State: The Emergency Power and Civil Liberties Under the Constitutional Act, 1980", and perhaps one might be misled in the expectation of content when the Canadian Mathematical Society discussed Lewis Carroll in a session entitled "Lewis Carroll's Curious Approach to Tournaments."

About 50 sessions were in progress at about 9:30 a.m. on that same day and it was impossible for someone interested in finding out what was offered to do anything but sample the menu of the day. However, the many visitors gathering in the pub of the Faculty Club, or wandering downtown continuing a discussion on subjects of their interest was evidence of the special intellectual climate prevalent during this Conference.

Who were the organizers? The Conference Office directed and organized the overall framework of the proceedings of the 64 societies. For each society, a local organizer, in co-operation with the society's executive, was responsible for the programme organization at Dalhousie University.

It is quite difficult to assess the costs of

such a conference. For once, societies have offered very different programmes to their members and this, of course, is reflected in the costs. In general, the costs per person amounted to about \$50.00 for all arrangements, including receptions, but excluding tours, dinners and other special arrangements.

What are the results of the Learned Societies Conference at Dalhousie? It is hoped scholars of the Humanities and Social Sciences across Canada — for the Learned is a conference primarily for academic societies of the Humanities and Social Sciences — have enjoyed their visit to Dalhousie. Every evening, between 5:30 and 6:30, the University and the Province of Nova Scotia hosted a reception, giving guests of different societies an opportunity to meet Dalhousie's President, Andrew MacKay, and to discuss their disciplines with each other. If there was a prevailing sense of community and sharing of ideas among delegates, then one of the main purposes of the Conference was fulfilled and the results, in years to come, will bear fruit.

Women's Division

The Annual Meeting of the Dalhousie Alumni Association Women's Division was held on April 25 in the Student Union Building.

Reports were presented for adoption by the chairwomen of the Division's various Committees. Each report indicated another successful year.

The Coffee Party Committee has started preparation for the annual event to be held on October 24 at Shirreff Hall.

Last March the Division sponsored a very successful and enjoyable fashion show. **Mrs. Pat Harris**, B.A. '54, LL.B. '57 a past Assistant Director of Alumni Affairs for Dalhousie, and now owner of Sagittarian Ltd., provided the fashions. Models, members of the alumni, included **Ruth Murray** Arts '37, **Ginny O'Connell** B.A. '67, **Elaine Gordon** D.D.S. '69, **Sylvia McGuire**, B.A. '78, B.Ed. '78 and **Sherry Hattin** B.Ed. '71. Another fashion show is planned for 1981-82.

Funds raised by the Division are used for scholarships and prizes, special projects and the restoration of antiques in the Victorian Lounge, one of the most used reception areas on campus.

Tigers continue strong tradition of success

Dalhousie alumni can be truly proud of the efforts of Dalhousie athletes during the 1980-81 season.

Six Atlantic Universities Athletic Association Championships were claimed while four teams travelled to the nationals. In addition, several other teams reached league finals or finished runners-up in tournament competition.

In the Fall of 1980, the field hockey team rolled through the regular schedule with a 10-1-1 record before falling in the league final 2-0 to University of New Brunswick. Pam Taylor of the Tigers was named an AUAA All-Star.

The soccer Tigers were undefeated through the regular schedule winning six and tying four. However, an eligibility technicality, discovered by the Dalhousie Athletic Department, cost the teams four games and eliminated what could have been a league champion. The Tigers were relegated to a non-playoff position with a 3-4-3 record. John Evans of the Tigers was named second team All-Canadian as well as being an AUAA All-Star along with Greg Forbes, Jack Hutchinson and Ron Robinson.

The Tiger golfers were also struck by the ineligibility bug. After winning the AUAA tournament by six strokes (Don Sutherland led the team with a 156 total), one of the Tigers was declared ineligible and the championship was taken away.

The cross country Tigers did well for a young team. The men finished fifth while the women captured second place. The highlight of the season was a winning performance by the women at the Fernand Grenier Race in Quebec, a 67 km event, in which the Tigers beat the existing record by more than 13 minutes.

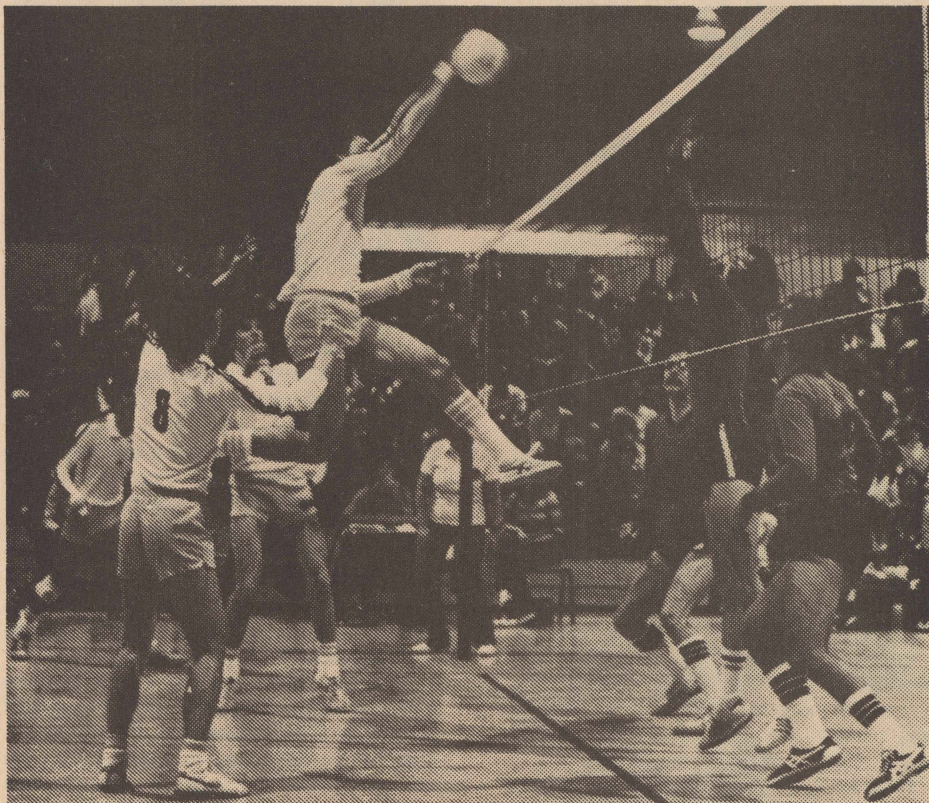
Dalhousie's tennis Tigers men's team won its 13th consecutive AUAA Championship with Jay Abbass, John Anderson, Jeff Morris and Tim Shoveller winning handily. The women, attempting to win their sixth consecutive title, finished fifth.

Brian Jessop of the men swimmers was unbeatable all year in AUAA meets and won the 1500 metres at the CIAU's.

The hockey Tigers came from far back to take second place in the Kelly Division of the AUAA. Coach Peter Esdale, named AUAA Coach of the Year, instilled confidence in the team, which had an 11-3-1 record in the last half of the schedule. Paced by league all stars John Kibyuk, Rick McCallum and Ken Johnston, the Tigers won sudden death quarter and semi-finals before losing to Moncton Blue Eagles in the league championship series.

The women volleyball Tigers placed two players on the CIAU All-Canadian team. Karin Maessen, earlier named Most Valuable Player in the AUAA, was first team while AUAA All-

Star Karen Fraser, was the second team. Both girls are on the Canadian Senior National team. Lois MacGregor was named AUAA Coach of the Year.

Men's basketball suffered through a 2-16 AUAA season but showed promise for the future with some entertaining and competitive basketball. They dropped close decisions to league powers Acadia (96-90) and Saint Mary's (72-71 and 92-88) to give the fans a great deal about which to cheer.

The wrestlers won a gold and silver in AUAA competition. Greg Wilson at 167 lbs. was undefeated in the AUAA in his five year Dal Career. Peter Coulthard was a silver medalist at 126 lbs. Wilson was fourth in his weight class at the CIAU's.

The track and field athletes won the AUAA championship for women with Karin Maessen winning three events and taking second in two others. Gordon Tynes won two events for the men who finished third.

Marcel Arseneault paced the Tiger divers with a first place finish in the one and three metre boards at AUAA's. He was 12th at one metre at the CIAU's and 18th at three metres.

ATHLETIC BANQUET HONORS ATHLETES

At seasons end, the Dalhousie Athletic Banquet saw the three highest varsity awards presented.

Greg Wilson, a wrestler who was undefeated in 204 bouts in his five year career at Dalhousie, took the Climo Trophy as the outstanding male athlete.

Karin Maessen won the Class of '55 Trophy for the second time. She showed her versatility as an athlete by winning the Most Valuable Player Award in AUAA Volleyball, being named first team All-Canadian and taking two Most Valuable Player Awards during tournaments throughout the season. In addition, Karin competed in track for the Tigers winning three golds and two silvers at the AUAA Championships. Later in the year, she was named a tournament all-star at the Canadian Senior Women's Basketball Championships and Nova Scotia's Female Amateur Athlete of the Year.

Peter Esdale, coach of the hockey Tigers, was named Coach of the Year at Dalhousie in a vote by his peers. He brought the Tigers from deep in the standings prior to Christmas to the runner-up position in the league.

It was an exciting year, a prosperous year and one which augers well for the next season of Tiger sports.

TIGERS TAKE CONFERENCE TITLES

The men's volleyball, women's swimming and men's and mixed badminton teams all won conference titles. The women's basketball team won 23 of 24 games against Canadian University competition but the only loss happened at a bad time — in the league playoffs and the girls were denied the opportunity to battle for national honors. The hockey Tigers finished second in the AUAA as did the women volleyballers and the men's, mixed, and women's curling teams. The women's badminton squad also took second place. The gymnasts won the AUAA title but were denied a trophy because not enough teams were in the competition. Dal's men swimmers lost the AUAA championship by one-half point to Acadia.

Volleyball men went through their AUAA season undefeated demolishing all opposition. At the CIAU's, they ran into much tougher foes and lost five matches.

Phil Perrin was named first team All-Canadian and Most Valuable Player of the AUAA. There were three AUAA volleyball all-stars among the Tigers — Jan Prsala, Bernie Derible and Rod Walsh. Coach Al Scott was named AUAA Coach of the Year.

Nigel Kemp's swimmers raced through the AUAA without losing. Fifteen swimmers qualified for the CIAU's — nine women and six men. Susan Mason was the AUAA Female Swimmer of the Year as she won just about every race she entered. At the nationals, she won the 800 free style. Dawn Suto set a new 200 metre back stroke record twice during the season.

Bruce Rawding and Ken Poole paced the badminton squads to their fine finishes.

ALL-CANADIANS

Carol Rosenthal of the basketball Tigers was named first team All-Canadian and Anna Pendergast was second team. Both were named to the AUAA All-Star team along with Jill Tasker.

Shawn Healey of gymnastics was the outstanding competitor at the AUAA meet but was injured at the CIAU's and his performance was hampered. Steve Bariks finished 17th for the Tigers in national competition.

105th Annual Meeting

Alumni President Dr. Doug Eisner, D.D.S. '55, welcomed alumni and guests to the Association's 105th Annual Meeting held on May 7 in "The Garden" of the Student Union Building.

Special guests at the meeting were the Classes of '21, '31, '41, '51, '56, '61, '71 and '81, University President W. Andrew MacKay, Honorary President 1980-81 Dr. Henry D. Hicks and Mrs. Hicks, Donald McInnes, O.C., Q.C., Honorary President 1981-82 and Mrs. McInnes and Dr. & Mrs. Basil Cooke.

The annual business was conducted after dinner and began with the adoption of yearly reports from the Association Treasurer, President and Director of Alumni Affairs, as well as affiliated alumni groups — Medical, Law, Library, Women's Division and Public Administration.

Donald McInnes, O.C., Q.C., was nominated as Honorary President for 1981-82 by Donald Grant, B.A. '30, LL.B. '32. The nomination was seconded by Peter Green, B.Com. '61, LL.B. '66 and was unanimously passed by the alumni.

Mr McInnes began his Dalhousie career back in 1924 when he graduated with his B.A. followed by his LL.B. in 1926. In 1941 he became a Q.C. Mr. McInnes has been President of the Canadian Bar Association. The University of Manitoba honored him with an LL.D. in 1961. He is currently Vice-President and Director of the Bank of Nova Scotia. For his 22 years service to Dalhousie, as Chairman of the Board of Governors, Mr. McInnes received a Doctor of Civil Law from Dalhousie in 1980, and an Honorary Life Membership in the Dal-

housie Alumni Association. Mr. McInnes is an Officer of the Order of Canada.

In accepting the nomination, Mr. McInnes recalled that his "roots" were Dalhousie. His parents and his children are all graduates of the university. His father, Hector, was also a long term Chairman of the Board of Governors.

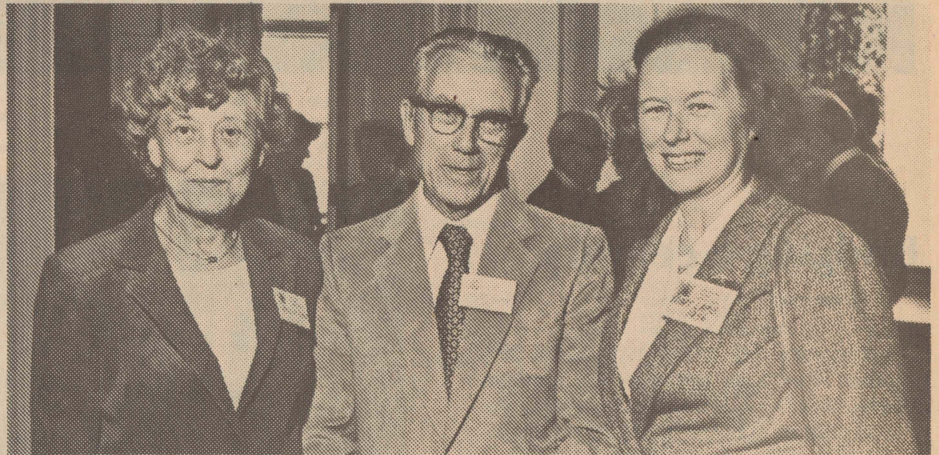

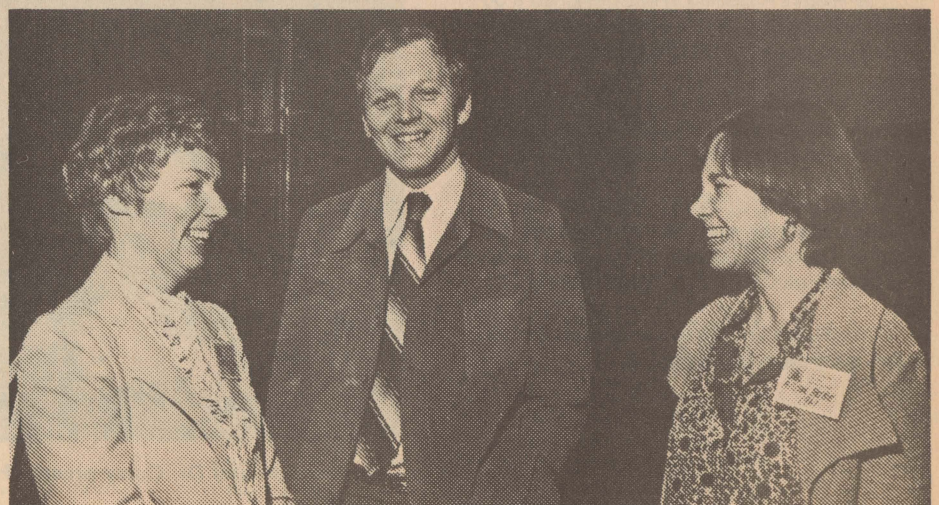

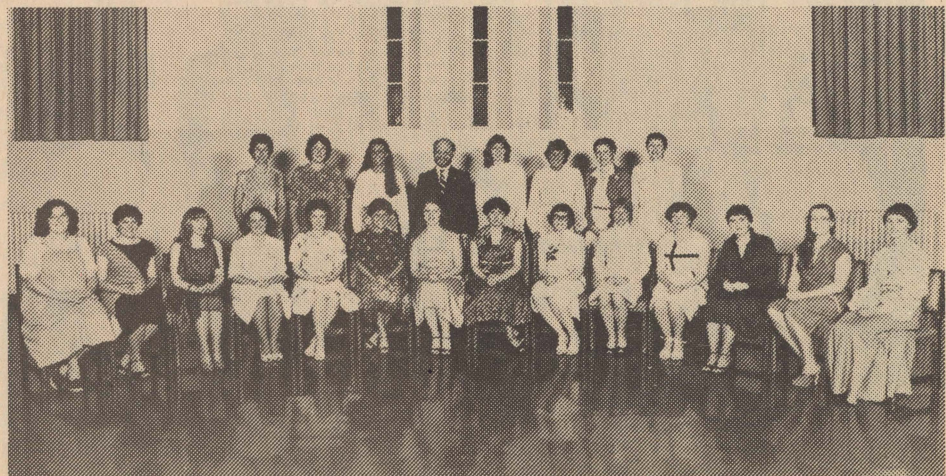

Medical graduating class starts new tradition

The 89 new young doctors who graduated from Dalhousie University Medical School this year started a new tradition when they collected \$800 amongst themselves and gave it for medical research in the Maritimes.

At a reception held for them by Dalhousie Medical Alumni Association, on the evening of May 21, president Dr. Douglas Brown, B.Sc. '52, M.D.C.M. '57, Halifax paediatric orthopaedic surgeon, received a cheque from newly qualified Dr. Tony Kelly, Enniskillen Station, N.B., life member of the executive of the Class of '81 with a class pledge to continue giving equal or larger amounts for the next 30 years.

The money is to be given initially to The Dalhousie Medical Research Foundation, and after the Foundation has a well established capital fund, the annual gift will be used by the Association for other worthy projects.

Dr. Kelly, former president of Dalhousie Medical Students' Society, and an originator of the idea, said: "In our own hearts we have always considered our Class and its spirit as something very unique and many of us feel we should mark our graduation with some gesture that will benefit not only the medical school, but also future generations of students."

He said junior colleagues support the idea of an annual donation from each graduating class and though the first contribution may seem meagre, it will quickly snowball into substantial income for the recipients.

"This final gesture as students, will create a tradition that will continue to benefit our medical school and its students for many years to come."

Dalhousie Medical Research Foundation was established less than three years ago with the aim of raising \$10 million to further research at Dalhousie, The Medical School of The Maritimes, and to encourage medical students to do research for at least part of their career.

The Class of '81 has already helped the Foundation financially with money raising projects and has helped to increase students' awareness of the importance of research.


Grants by the Foundation to first year medical students of merit have already provided career focus and summer employment to seven successful contenders who now do research under the guidance of senior investigators at Dalhousie University and its affiliated hospitals.

Alumni recognize Cooke's quality teaching

Dr. Basil Cooke, teacher, scientist, administrator and friend, is this year's recipient of the Alumni Award for Teaching Excellence.

Dr. Cooke was nominated several times each year since the award's conception. Reading through supporting letters, the same theme is realized — Dr. Cooke's interest in his students, subject, excellent class preparation . . .

"The fact that the students seek his advice in preference to that of others is an indication that he is interested in all students and that they respect his judgement and find his advice very helpful. Truth to tell, his colleagues consult him for the same reasons".

" . . . he is one of the best four or five teachers I have ever met".

"The lectures were extremely well organized . . . he has a special way of simplifying problems."

" . . . Dr. Cooke is the person most responsible for turning me into a geologist".

"He has consistently set a very high standard of teaching in the department".

" . . . he was able to strike an effective balance between inspiring academic leadership and fatherly personal interest".

Dr. Cooke was born in South Africa. He studied at Cambridge and the University of Witwatersrand.

Before coming to Dalhousie in 1961 he was chairman of the Bernard Price Institute of Palaeontological Research and Reader in Strategic Geology at the University of Witwatersrand, the title of reader being a rare one bestowed for outstanding academic distinction.

Two years after joining the Dalhousie faculty, Dr. Cooke was named Dean of the Fac-

ulty of Arts & Science.

During his five year term, the Faculty more than doubled its size and Senior Matriculation, rather than Grade XI, became the entrance requirement.

At Dalhousie, Dr. Cooke and his wife were very active in campus affairs. Dr. Cooke played a major role in campus planning and was influential in the design details of several new buildings, including the Chemistry Link, the Arts Centre, Killam Library and Life Science Centre. The Student Union awarded him a special gold medal for his contribution to the work on the Student Union Building.

In 1967, Dr. Cooke, responding to pressure from colleagues in other institutes, returned to Africa and resumed his research with fossil mammals and with the establishment of a sound time framework for the deposits containing the stone tools and fossil remains of early man. During expeditions, mainly in East Africa and Ethiopia, Dr. Cooke was associated with such well known figures as Louis and Mary Leakey, Richard Leakey, Clark Howell, Yves Coppens, Bryan Patterson and Don Johanson.

After returning to full time teaching, Dr. Cooke continued to be involved in campus affairs and chaired many Senate, Faculty and other committees. At Dalhousie, Dr. Cooke became involved with studies on glaciation in Nova Scotia as well as the earth's magnetic field during the past six million years.

Dr. Cooke is the author of several text and scientific papers, including a geology text for South African students (five editions) and a volume on the history of science in South Africa. He has been a guest speaker at many American and European institutions.

Dr. Cooke retires in August and he and his wife plan to move to Vancouver in the fall.

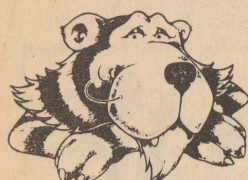

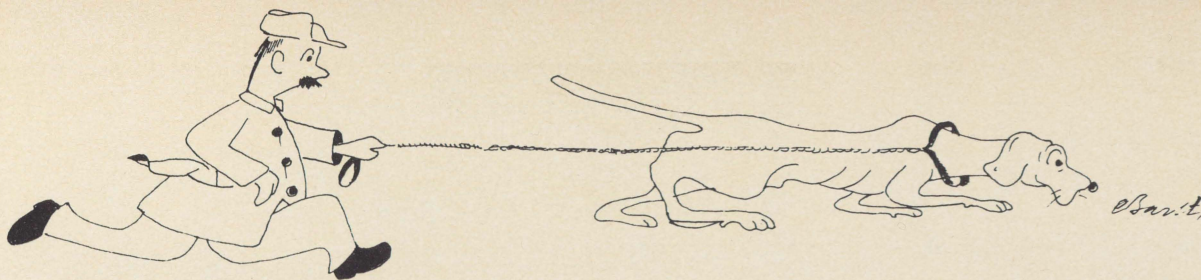
