Director's Notes - JACQUES BREL

Four times a year, the Department of Theatre comes together to produce DTDP. Our season is intended to serve all students of the Department of Theatre, as well as you, our audience.

JACQUES BREL has been a fascinating experience from the beginning. and those of us who have been involved have had a remarkable ride. This show has tested the training in many ways. First, we have had the wonderful experience in the Acting Programme of having the opportunity to see if we can carry this musical evening. Initially, we were somewhat lost without text and a story line or plot to cling to. However, with some help from the translation, the use of textual analysis techniques (thank God for voice and speech and analysis class) and the knowledgeable assistance of the musical directors, we began to realise that this piece could be, and indeed was, a genuine challenge to everyone involved. On the evening of January 25th, the students of the Acting Programme tentatively shared their early explorations and we attempted to establish a gentle shape to this evening. It was the first time many of the solo numbers had an audience and the quality of the rehearsal was remarkable. We hope that we can share some of that magic and that this production might put you in touch with the extraordinary music and timeless lyrics of JACQUES BREL.

Again I thank the students of the Acting Programme for their constant courage, discipline and dedication. They are fortunate to have the opportunity to explore their craft in a public forum, and we hope to succeed a little, grow a great deal and fail well, if necessary. My sincere appreciation to the dance and singing instructors who have managed to do so much in such a limited amount of time. I also thank the students involved in the creation of the set and costumes and the dedication of the Department as a whole. It is our hope that this production of JACQUES BREL proves once and for all that the Department of Theatre is alive and well and living in the Arts Centre.
