Following are the Federal Government contributions in respect of programs operated under the Vocational Training Act in Nova Scotia for the fiscal year 1953-54:

Training of Unemployed	\$ 76,741.15
Youth Training, including Student Aid	39,099.37
Training for the Armed Forces	5,917.63
Training of Workers for Defence Industries	56,947.26
Apprentice Training	47,312.60
Assistance to Vocational Schools, Annual Allotment	119,559.39
Vocational Correspondence Courses	309.00
