



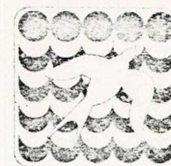

Pacem in Maribus

Following an invitation from the Government of Mexico, the Planning Council of the International Ocean Institute (Pacem in Maribus) is scheduling its next session in Mexico on January 13-15, 1975.

The Council is organizing a SEMINAR in which our members will be joined by a number of experts from Latin American and Caribbean countries. We would be honored if you would accept to participate in this capacity. We expect the total number of participants to be between 40 and 50. I am enclosing a list of our Council members and a tentative list of additional invit es from Latin American and Caribbean nations.

The topics for discussion will be two:

1. Latin American and Caribbean cooperation in the light of trends developed at Caracas. I am enclosing a paper written by Ambassador Reynaldo Galindo-Pohl for our Caribbean project two years ago. In many ways, this could serve as a basis for discussion. Would it be possible to write down your comments, especially on the passages I marked on the margins? It would be most helpful if your comments, as short or as long as you wish to make them, could reach us by December 15.
2. The second topic will be the question of how to include the water column in the deliberations aiming at the establishment of an international authority beyond the limits of national jurisdiction, or, alternatively, how to create a system integrating the activities of the newly established sea-bed authority with the activities of a restructured IOC, FAO Fisheries Committee and IMCO, so as to create a rational management system for ocean space and resources. We are working on a paper of this sort right now and would like to submit it as a basis for discussion.

A detailed schedule and information about the place of the meeting and accommodations, as well as the background paper on the second topic, will be sent to you early in December. In the meantime I would be very grateful for your reply in principle.

Needless to say, we shall be glad to pay your travel expenses and sojourn.
