Thank you for your enquiry.

On April 2,1963, I signed my last contracts with Doubleday Canada, and Doubleday. New York. They covered three books that I had in mind, as follows:-

1. Hangman's Beach, a historical novel.

2. Footsteps On Old Floors, a collection of true tales.

3. A history and description of Sable Island.

Up to this time I had enjoyed my relations with Doubleday and was satisfied with their handling of my books.

However when Hangman's Beach was published I found that the trade wind on Park Avenue had changed for the worse, as far as my books were concerned. (My friend at New York, Tom Costain, had died in the meantime.) The New York promotion of Hangman's Beach was small and perfunctory, and when I protested to Ken McCormick his reply amounted to a polite shrug.

I wrote and delivered Footsteps On Old Floors, which got the same treatment. In this case, of course, I knew that short stories of this short are not as popular as novels.

That left the third item in the 1963 contracts. I knew that a book of this kind could have no wide appeal, but George Nelson agreed to include it because as a Canadian author I felt it should be written, even though it could bring no profit to Doubledgy or to me. However, while I was still gathering material for it, I met a naval officer of a literary bent who had been working on the same thing, and I was happy to show him what I had, and to give him permission to use it in his own book. Thus the 1963 contracts are now closed.

On Oct.7,1966, David Nelson wrote to inform me that New York had let Halifax, Warden Of The North go out of print in 1967, and that the plates had been destroyed, without notifying me or your people in Toronto. I got the message in all respects.


