Dear Mr Raddall,

We understand from Mr G. T. Feilding of McClelland and Stewart Ltd. that you control the copyright in your short story "The Amulet". We should very much like to include this story in a collection of Ghost Stories made by Miss Kathleen Lines, which we are planning to publish next year, and would therefore be grateful for your permission to do so, to cover world rights. Perhaps you would let us know also what form the acknowledgment should take. There are, however, one or two small changes Miss Lines would like to make to the text, and I hope you will allow this. She would like to add "Indian" after "Mikmac" in Line 22 on Page 134, and "Roman" before "Catholic" two lines further on. Then, at the end of the story she would like to substitute "older clergyman" for "small grey man" in Line 10 on Page 145. Miss Lines' book is intended for older teenagers, and she feels that these slight additions will help to clarify what might be obscure to the English reader.
