Two GROUPS OF EXAMINERS QUESTION THE FINAL YEAR STUDENTS, ONE FROM THE UNIVERSITY AND PROVINCIAL MEDICAL BOARD, AND THE OTHER FROM THE MEDICAL COUNCIL OF CANADA. THESE EXAMINATIONS RUN ON A VERY TIGHT SCHEDULE. THEY WERE COMPLETED AT 5:00 P.M. ON THE 12TH. THE JOINT EXAMINING BOARD MET AT 7:00 P.M., FOLLOWED BY THE FACULTY COUNCIL AT 9:00 P.M. RECOMMENDATIONS WENT TO THE FACULTY MEETING ON THE 13TH, AND TO THE UNIVERSITY SENATE ON THE 14TH. CONVOCATION WAS HELD ON THE FOLLOWING TUESDAY MAY 17TH. IN FUTURE YEARS CONVOCATION IS TO BE HELD ON THURSDAY, WHICH WILL RELIEVE THE LAST-MINUTE RUSH SOMEWHAT, AND OF MORE IMPORTANCE, IT WILL PERMIT AT LEAST ONE WEEK OF FREE

TIME FOR THE FOURTH YEAR STUDENTS. UNDER THE PRESENT SYSTEM THEY
HAVE A RATHER ROUGH HURDLE AT THE END OF THE YEAR. THE COMPLETION
OF A HEAVY EXAMINATIONS SCHEDULE, FOLLOWED ALMOST IMMEDIATELY BY
THE FIRST WEEK OF INTERNSHIP, WITH ALL ITS TENSIONS, SHOULD BE
RELIEVED SOMEWHAT. HOWEVER, DALHOUSIE UNIVERSITY HAS TO FIT IN
TO THE SCHEDULE OF FIVE OTHER CANADIAN UNIVERSITIES, WHICH GIVE
THE MEDICAL COUNCIL EXAMINATIONS AT THE SAME TIME.
