My own little Jessie

Just arrived here  
a few minutes ago. Have had a queer old  
time since I wrote this other scuddle.

Went on board ship last night at 2<sup>45</sup>  
& there wasn't a light to be seen. There were  
you of us altogether & none of us had been  
on board the new boat before. He rooked  
around for half an hour & then by the  
help of some matches found the dining  
saloon, the only one on board, as there are  
no state rooms at all. Then we found  
that all the lights were switched off

from the dynamo so of course we couldn't  
get any light. I left the others & went  
all over the ship & at last right down  
at the boiler room found some men  
working & when they werent looking I  
gassed a lantern & beat it for the upper  
deck. Two of the boys then went to bed  
& the other fellow & I rampaged all over  
the ship till at last we struck the  
pantry. We tried the door & it opened.  
There we found some soda biscuits &  
other stuff so we had a feed & then beat  
it back & I curled up on a lounge &  
went to sleep at 4<sup>15</sup> A.M.

This morning we had breakfast on board.

It was pretty rough crossing & about 10 miles off here we began to run into shoal water & to make matters worse a blinding snowstorm came on. The Captain gave orders to anchor so there we lay for about an hour until the snow equally passed & then let out for here. It was pretty cold but I bet you'd have enjoyed the fun if you had been there & heaven knows if wishing could do it you'd have been just about 3 minutes coming from Halifax to the ship.
