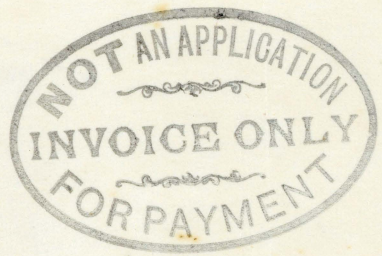


We thank you for your letter of 18th July enclosing a remittance for £1, our receipt for which has been posted to you separately.
