Having returned to Italy, I would like to thank you once again for your hospitality at Split and for the interesting meeting. The ideas, suggestions and considerations of different kinds which emerged from the contributions of the several participants are many.

Thinking over all that has been said and reading the papers (very different among themselves), it seems to me that the material which has been gathered together is a useful basis for further exploration of many topics of study. Since the political and economic divisions of the Mediterranean world are at present very difficult to surmount, cooperation in the field of technical and economic research toward the solution of the many common problems is an important path toward agreement among the various countries. A Mediterranean university open to young people from all the countries would really be a great achievement.

I will presently look over my paper and I will send it with the data and the charts. I hope to be able continue the study of the problems of Italian participation in the life of the Mediterranean basin; but I will not be able to come to Malta because I am very busy right now and for this reason cannot at present prepare new material. I hope, at last, to read the conclusions of the conference.

Cara Elisabetta,



Il Kaysert la faccia poco lunga! Se le poste francesi non funzionano peggio per lui!

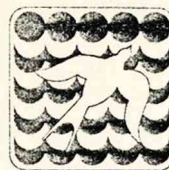

The International Ocean Institute takes pleasure in inviting you to attend Pacem in Maribus V, to be held in Malta from September 9 through 13, 1974.

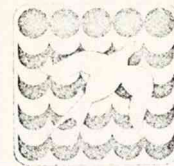
As during the past four Convocations, we shall have the participation of distinguished statesmen and legal experts, industrialists, fishery experts, ocean scientists, ecologists, and students and junior civil servants, with a maximum interaction among these groups.

The Convocation will be presided over by H.E. Mr. H. Shirley Amerasinghe of the Republic of Sri Lanka who, as you know, is President of the U.N. Conference on the Law of the Sea. Sir Anthony Mamo, Governor-General of Malta, will be the Honorary Chairman. The inauguration will take place on September 9 at 8:00 p.m. at the Corinthia Palace Hotel.

The Convocation will deal with two major topics:

1. An assessment of the results of the Caracas session of the U.N. Conference on the Law of the Sea, with special emphasis on
 - a. The implications of the Economic Zone concept for the development of an international ocean regime, and
 - b. The prospects for arms control and disarmament in the oceans. This topic will be introduced by Mrs. Alva Myrdal of Sweden on the afternoon of September 13. Her presentation will be followed by a report by Dr. N. K. Panikkar of India on the Indian Ocean as a Zone of Peace, and by general discussion.
2. The development of the living resources of the Mediterranean. This topic will be introduced by Dr. Sidney Holt, Director of the IOI.
