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This Indenture made the twentieth
day of April in the Year of our Lord one thousand
nine hundred and seven

Between Jedidah G Burns of Shelburne in
the County of Shelburne and Province of Nova
Scotia Married woman the wife of Samuel W Burns
of Shelburne a forecaid Doctor of Medicine and
the said Samuel W Burns of the one part and
Archibald Supper of Milton in the County of
Queens and Province a forecaid Gentleman of
the other part

Whereas in and by a certain Indenture
bearing date the twenty second day of September
in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight
hundred and seventy nine and duly recorded
in the office of the Registrar of Deeds in
Liverpool in the said County of Queens indiber
28; folio 273 Nelson & McLeod of Liverpool a forecaid
Esquire and Louisa McLeod his wife for the
consideration therein mentioned did grant
sell and convey to the said Jedidah G Burns
(then Jedidah G Supper) her heirs and assigns

purposes that upon the coming of age of the
said Archibald Supper (son of the said

Now this Indenture witnesseth that the
said Jedidah G Burns and Samuel W Burns
in and in consideration of the sum of one
dollar of lawful money of Canada to them
in hand well and truly paid by the said
Archibald Supper at and before the execution
and delivery of these presents (the receipt
whereof is hereby acknowledged) have

and each of them hath granted bargained sold
aliened conveyed released conveyed and
confirmed and by these presents do and each
of them doth grant bargain sell alien convey
release convey and confirm unto the said
Archibald Tait for his heirs and assigns the
following described lot piece and parcel of
land situate lying and being at Murray's
Hill near Milton in the County of Queens above
said being the same lot of land conveyed to
Nelson & McLeod as by deed from Joseph Drummond
to the said Nelson & McLeod dated the 10th April
1867 and duly recorded in the office of Registry
of Deeds Liverpool in Liber 20 folio 415 will more
fully appear which said lot of land contains
twenty acres together with all and singular
the houses buildings ways water water
courses easements covenants hereditaments
and appurtenances to the said lot of land belonging
in any wise appertaining and the reversion and
reversions remainder and remainders rents issues
and profits thereof and all the estate right title
interest claim property and demand whatsoever
