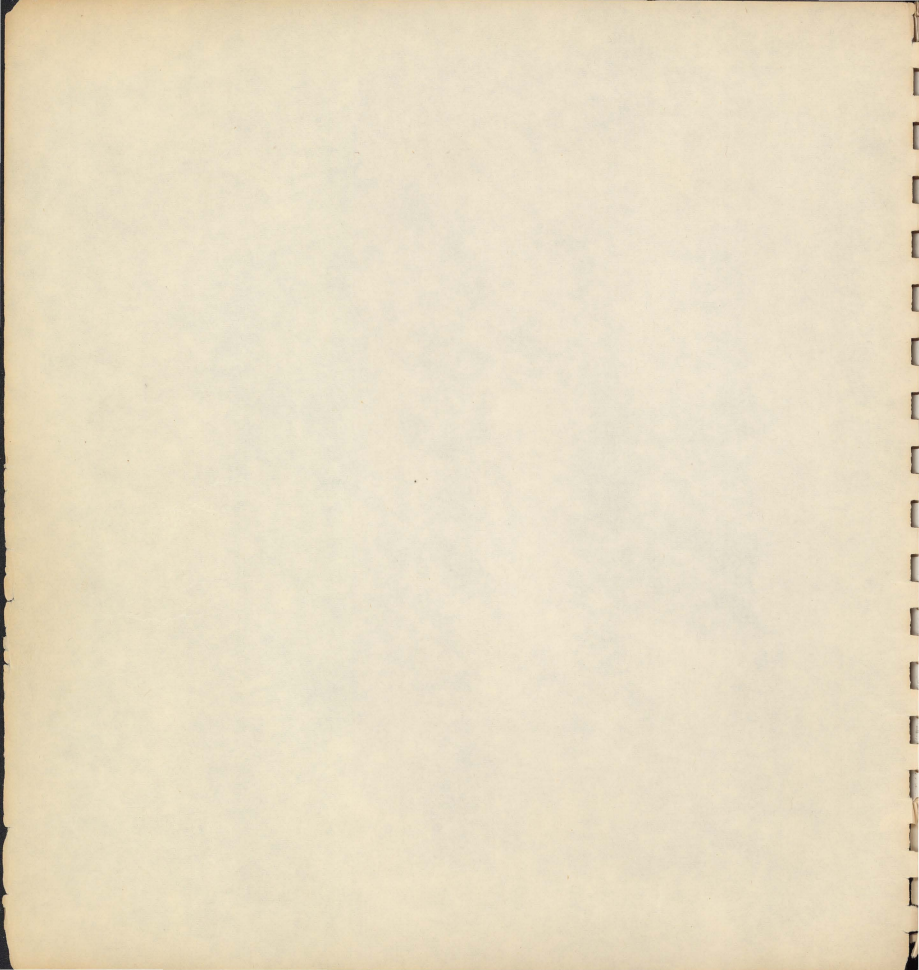

### The Nova Scotia Tartan

REG. 131-19590

THE TARTAN reproduced on the background of the cover was originated and designed by Mrs. Bessie E. Murray, President of the Halifax Weavers' Guild. It has been accepted by the Nova Scotia Government as the official tartan of the Province and has been registered with the Lyon Court of the Lord Lyon King of Arms of Scotland.

The colors and color arrangement of the Nova Scotia flag are duplicated in the new Nova Scotia tartan. There is the October blue of the sea while the light and dark greens represent the deciduous and evergreen trees of Nova Scotia. Against these background colors is a line of white, for the salt, a gold line for our Royal charter, and a red line to represent the Lion rampant on the Nova Scotia crest.

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## North Strait Skies

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NOVA SCOTIA, originally "Acadia," a Province of Canada, consists of an extensive peninsula, with an extreme length of 381 miles, breadth varying from 50 to 150 miles, and area of 21,068 square miles, of which 686 square miles is water. Its connection with New Brunswick is over an isthmus 15 miles wide. The Island of Cape Breton, 4,198 square miles in area, is separated from the mainland by the narrow Strait of Canso; this was created by a Causeway completed in 1954.

This seagirt Province was discovered by John Cabot in 1497, colonized by the French in 1604, and by the first English settlers in 1623. After changing hands several times, it was finally ceded to England by the Treaty of Utrecht in 1713. In travelling through the royal Province of Nova Scotia, with its deeply indented shore line of 5,000 miles, jutting far out into the Atlantic Ocean, one sees many marvels of scenic grandeur in the structure of the several long lying mountain ranges and glacial sculptured landforms.

It has one National Park, 391 square miles in area, located in the northern Highlands of Inverness and Victoria Counties, and extending from the Gulf of St. Lawrence on the west to the Atlantic Ocean on the east.

Modern highways which extend from end to end of Nova Scotia present fascinating glimpses of the sea and charming inland vistas.

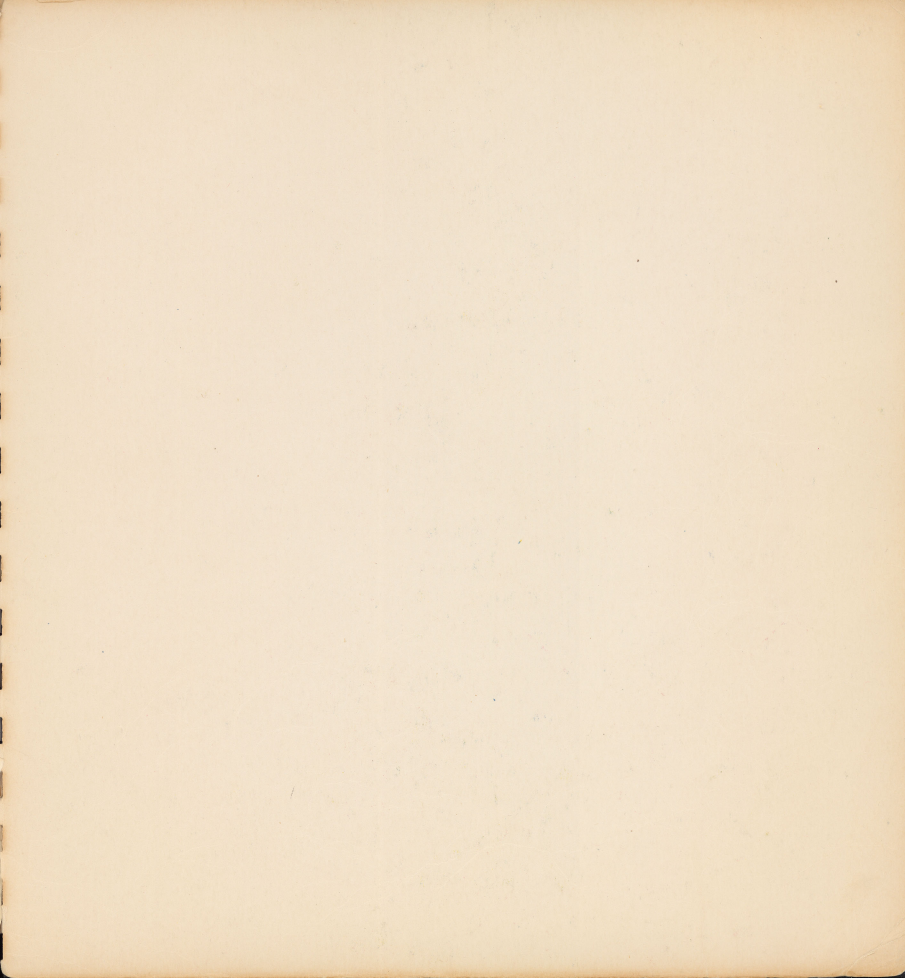
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
