

#### Dear Mr. Nandan:

Thank you for the opportunity to meet with you during my visit to New York last week. I am submitting the following as an informal record of our discussion with identification of follow-up activities.

#### Fellowships:

As discussed, ICOD is prepared to consider sponsorship of one or more finalists in the Hamilton Shirley Amerasinghe Fellowship. We are currently examining the procedures we might follow in this regard and will be back to you shortly with our views. You are aware that any candidate we sponsor will have to be from one of our target countries, a list of which is attached.

#### Follow-up on ICOD's Ocean Forum

In follow-up to our own discussion of ICOD's Ocean Forum on the "Contribution of Ocean and Ocean Development to Wealth and Welfare in the Particular Reference to Developing Countries", I had discussions on the subject in Washington with the World Bank. I understand that the Bank intends to publish a compendium entitled "Environmental and Resource Accounting and Their Relevance to The Measurement of Sustainable Income". An Expert Group met in Vienna during March 1988 to discuss environmental and resource accounting issues and the forthcoming compendium is

expected as a follow up to this meeting. It will be useful to examine what the compendium contains before considering any further action. In the meantime, I am sending under separate cover, a copy of the paper presented by Prof. Orio Giarini and Dr. Max Börlin at the ICOD Ocean Forum, for your information.

#### Country Data Base

During our discussion, I indicated that we were in the process of preparing profiles on ICOD target and secondary focus countries. Access to your own country data base would be very helpful to us in this regard. I would be grateful if you would ask your staff to send us a printout of your data base on all of our target and secondary focus countries in the South Pacific, the Caribbean Basin, South West Indian Ocean and West Africa. Alternately, it might be possible for us to access it through a network. If this is the case, please let me know so that we can make the necessary arrangements. A list of our target and secondary focus countries is attached.

#### Non-Fuel Minerals Course

I was pleased to note that you are agreeable to make available Mr. Nii Odunton for the mineral course to be held in Accra in November 1989. I assume that, as a contribution from the UN, this will include the underwriting of his expenses. We are confident that he can make a positive contribution to the course.

#### WMU Simulation

As I indicated, it is our understanding that this project would be jointly published after making further necessary refinements to the text. You agreed to look into this matter and I would appreciate hearing your subsequent views on this joint effort.

Thank you for your letter of May 3 bringing me up to date on your sabbatical leave and the current situation at the University of Dar Es Salaam.

You asked whether ICOD would be interested in funding two doctoral level scholarships. To date, ICOD has restricted its scholarship activities to the diploma and masters degree levels. However, the division of ICOD responsible for training programmes has been mandated to conduct a feasibility study to examine the possibility of broadening ICOD's scholarship programmes to include undergraduate as well as doctoral level scholarships. This study will take place once the evaluation of our current scholarship programmes has been completed.

Therefore, it will be several months before ICOD can really respond to your question. It might therefore be advisable for you to seek other potential sources of funding for the PhD programmes of the two candidates mentioned. You might apply to the International Development Research Centre at 250 Albert Street, Ottawa, Ont. KIG 3H9

I have asked Dr. Carol Amaratunga of our Interregional and Cooperative Activities Division to keep a copy of this correspondence so that she can let you know the results of the feasibility study when it is completed. I wish you success in your future endeavours.
