Thank you for your contribution, and I hope that the final product is satisfactory.

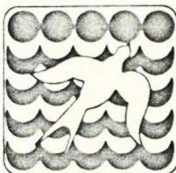

However, I think the final product will meet with your satisfaction.

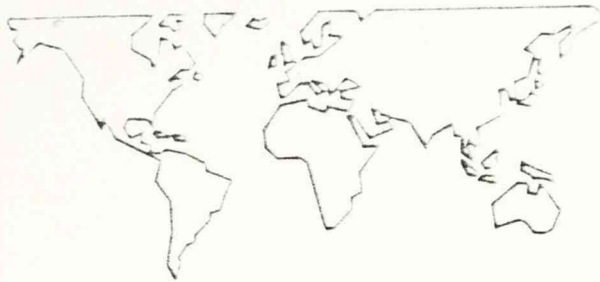
Would you be so kind as to send me as soon as possible a one or two line statement on your co-author Velez -- I need some statement for purposes of the list of contributors.

Dear Rodd:

I am just back from Jamaica (Sea-bed) and find here our book on my desk. It is a nice volume, and you have done a fine job.

But there is one thing, which is probably not your fault, but you ought to know about it: There is a misstatement about the genesis of the conference, and Facet in Maribus XII is not mentioned at all.

The idea of the conference was not Alva Myrdal's, it was mine, and she received it enthusiastically and generously. But let that rest. She was a marvellous person. I mention it only in order to show you the whole approach of those who were in charge of the Myrdal Foundation. They behaved unethically, to put it mildly.

The omission of the reference to Facet in Maribus is unacceptable. It is against all agreements, reference to the IOI and to me personally is not adequate.

Had you shown me the edited MS of the bulletin, as we had agreed, this could easily have been avoided. In fact.

I am sending a copy of this letter to the President of our Board. He may request rectification.

Incidentally, it is also difficult to see how "a large part" of the "total prize" could have been spent on that little conference and for getting out a little book that is not even type-set. Obviously, another misstatement.
