I am in the process of tidying-up my publishing affairs, hence I ask you now for a formal letter covering the reversion of all rights in the following titles published in hardback by your firm, and long out of print:-

HIS MAJESTY'S YANKEES	(originally published	1942)
ROGER SUDDEN	"	" 1944)
THE WINGS OF NIGHT	"	" 1956)
THE GOVERNOR'S LADY	"	" 1960)
HANGMAN'S BEACH	"	" 1966)

Paperback editions were subsequently published by Popular Library in arrangement with your firm as follows:-

HIS MAJESTY'S YANKEES	(published	1969)
THE GOVERNOR'S LADY	"	"
HANGMAN'S BEACH	"	"

These paperback editions now seem to be out of print. ~~xx~~ If Popular Library intends to reprint promptly you can of course make provision for this in your letter of reversion.

Not mentioned above is the third volume in the Canadian History series edited by Tom Costain, entitled THE PATH OF DESTINY. I presume that Doubleday Canada intends to keep this in print for some time yet.

Other titles not mentioned above are PRIDE'S FANCY, for which Doubleday gave me a letter of reversion on March 11, 1947. ~~xx~~ And FOOTSTEPS ON OLD FLOORS, for which Doubleday gave me a letter of reversion on Feb. 18, 1971.

Dear Ken:

In your letter of October 26/73 you told me "we can't revert the rights on HIS MAJESTY'S YANKEES, THE GOVERNOR'S LADY and HANGMAN'S BEACH because they are in paperback".

Meaning, of course, the Popular Library edition of 1969.

My records show no returns whatever from the Popular Library edition of HIS MAJESTY'S YANKEES since April 30, 1971.

My records show a royalty return of \$25 on the Popular Library edition of THE GOVERNOR'S LADY for the year 1973, paid to me by Doubleday in February 1974.

My records show a royalty return of \$3.80 on the Popular Library edition of HANGMAN'S BEACH for the year 1973, paid by Doubleday in February 1974.

Ken, the utter absence of royalty returns on HIS MAJESTY'S YANKEES since 1971, and the small returns on the others for 1973, show clearly that all three must be out of print now.

I ask you again for the reversion of all rights in these books.
