I can let you have Parkman's Wolfe and Moncalm
as follows

- set 1 2 vols. binding not uniform. vol.1 brown cloth
vol.2. 3/4 leather price \$ 1.50
- set 2. 2 vols. binding uniform brown cloth price \$ 2.00
postage about 25c

I have done some research on your behalf to-day about the 2nd.
seige of Louisburg. You would find Bourinot's "Cape Breton and
its Memorials" very useful. There 13 folio pages on this seige
with numerous notes of great interest and an appendix giving list
of books and other very useful information. There maps and illustrations.

This work came out in the Roayl Society in 1891. There 270 folio
pages. I have had it bound in boards and usually get \$ 6.00 for it
but could let you have it at \$ 4.50 postage about 25c. Then I have
quite a rare book ,Parson U. "The life of Sir William Pepperrell, The
only baronet of N.E. in pre-revolutionary times. London. 1856." Deal s
with both seiges and contains letters and documents long unknown
to exist. Price 3.00 postage 16c. Otherwise you would have to go
to general histories which only touch on it.
