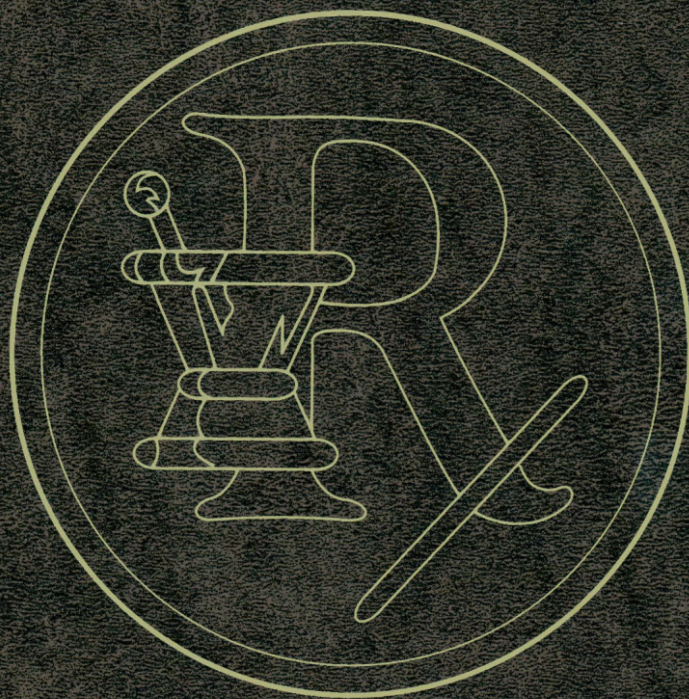

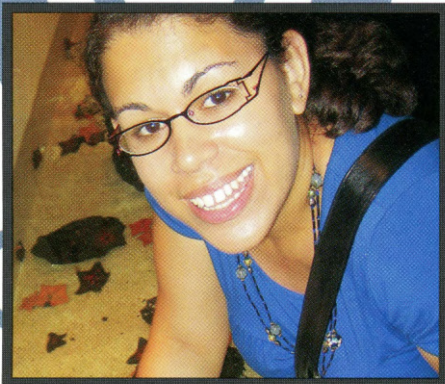

# Director's Message

On behalf of the faculty and staff of the College of Pharmacy, I am pleased to have the opportunity to extend our warmest congratulations to the Class of 2009.

It is hard to believe that four years have flown by so quickly. The past four years have been an exciting time in the College's history. The Dalhousie Student Pharmacy Society (DSPS) won the A-level Student Society of the Year Award, sponsored by the Dalhousie Student Union. This was the second time in four years that the DSPS has received this award. In 2007, it was wonderful to see the graduating class and the DSPS establish the Dalhousie Pharmacy Student Endowment Award to assist future generations of pharmacy students. This year, with the assistance of your graduating class and the DSPS, it has grown from \$10,000 to over \$40,000, and we were able to provide three awards to our students for their professional development.

The faculty and staff have been busy with a number of major initiatives. We are awaiting the Board of Governors approval for a new graduate program in pharmaceutical sciences, scheduled to start in the fall of 2010. Another major initiative has been preparing for our site visit in September 2010 from the Canadian Council for Accreditation of Pharmacy Programs (CCAPP). The last two site visits, while I have been Director, have resulted in the College receiving the highest possible awards. We have also developed a new College of Pharmacy Strategic Plan to see us through the next five years. We are confident we can respond and support the new vision for the pharmacy profession that focuses on our role as medication experts committed to patient-centered, outcome-focused care.

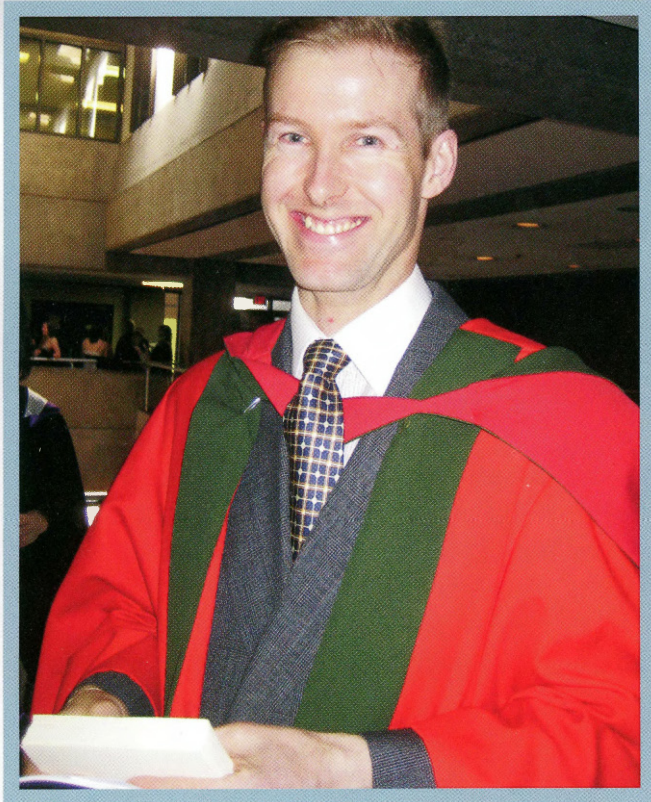

## Jessie I. MacKnight Teaching Excellence Award Dr. Hoan Linh Banh



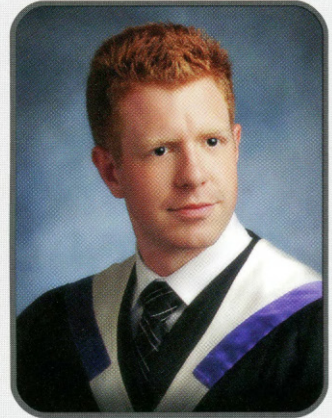
