From the introduction to Studs Terkel's WORKING:

It is about a search, too, for daily meaning as well as daily bread, for recognition as well as cash, for astonishment rather than torpor; in short, for a sort of life rather than a Monday to Friday sort of dying. Perhaps immortality, too, is part of the quest. To be remembered was the wish, spoken and unspoken, of the heroes and heroines of this book.

It has been a great pleasure to work on this production. I have been intrigued by Studs Terkel's book for many years, and was delighted to discover that a Broadway musical had been based on this fascinating collection of interviews with everyday people.

For the past five weeks, the building has been literally full of rehearsals.
