During Open House, TUNS students demonstrated that they could build the nation's future (out of Lego blocks) while the professors demonstrated that they could demonstrate.

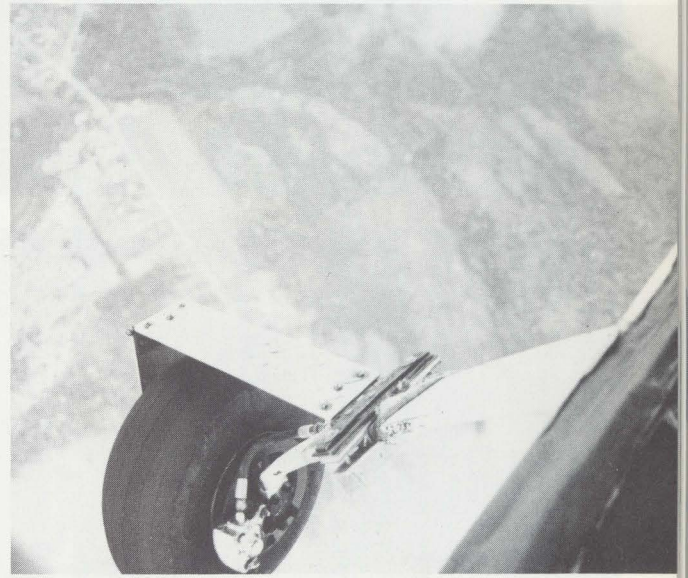

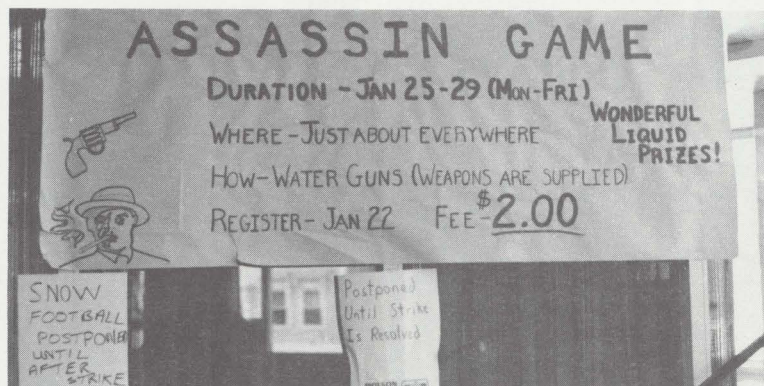


STRIKE HIGHLIGHTS

- JAN 12: Student Action Committee (SAC) was formed to deal with strike issues. A general assembly was held with the majority of students in favour of a march on Province House.
- JAN 15: TUNSFA members walked off the job at 12:30 p.m. shortly after receiving their paycheques
- JAN 18: Students stage a "March of Concern" on Province House. Form letters calling for a "quick and amiable" solution to the strike were presented to the Minister of Higher Education - Edmund Morris. The words "quick and amiable" begin to appear in strike news coverage.
- JAN 20: Students presented their concerns to TUNSFA and the Board of Governors at the Hotel Nova Scotian.
- JAN 21: Members of SAC resigned.
- JAN 25: Group of students marched down Barrington St. to file for unemployment insurance benefits. In the evening a candlelight vigil was held as TUNSFA and BOG members entered their respective meetings.
- JAN 27: Provincial government appointed industrial commissioner to help settle the dispute.
- JAN 29: Students held meeting and erected banners on Barrington St. and Spring Garden Rd.
- JAN 30: TUNSFA and BOG reached a tentative agreement.
- FEB 1: TUNSFA ratified the agreement and classes resumed at 12:30 p.m.

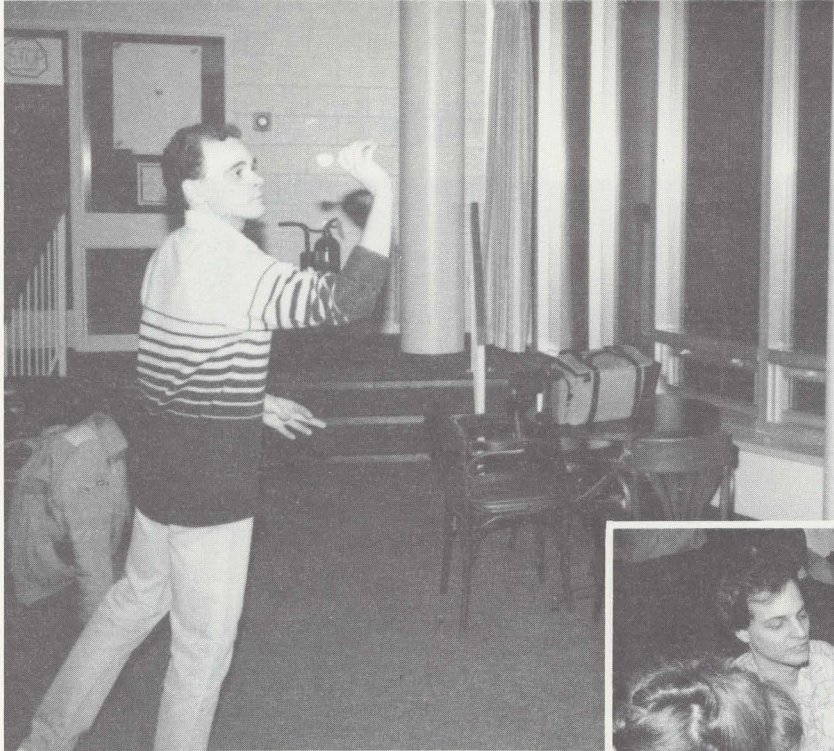
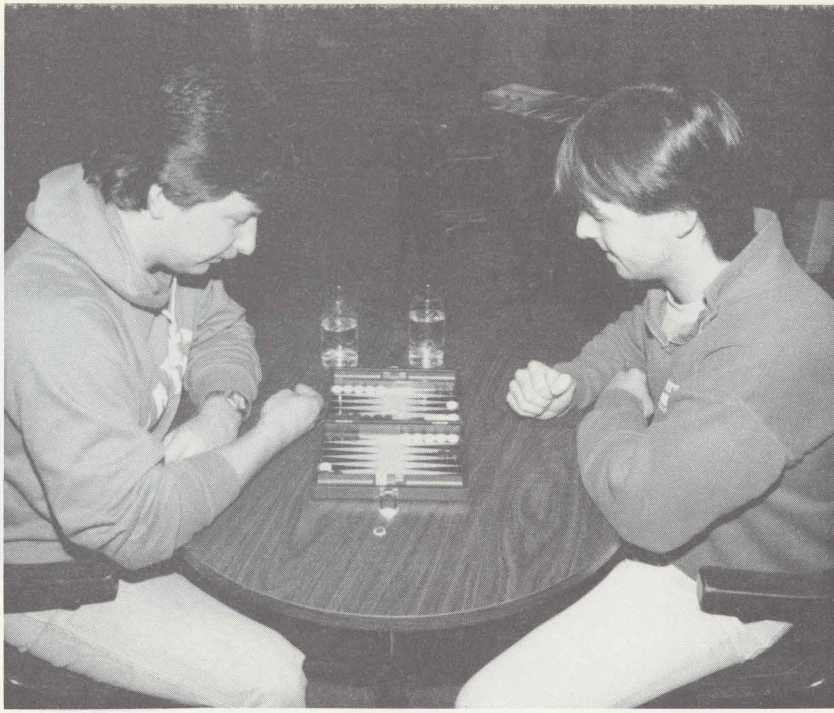


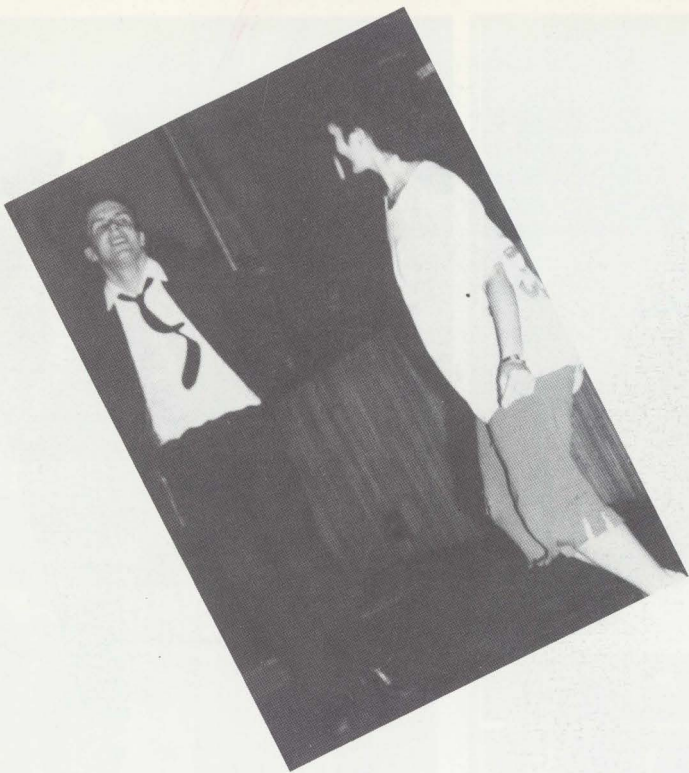

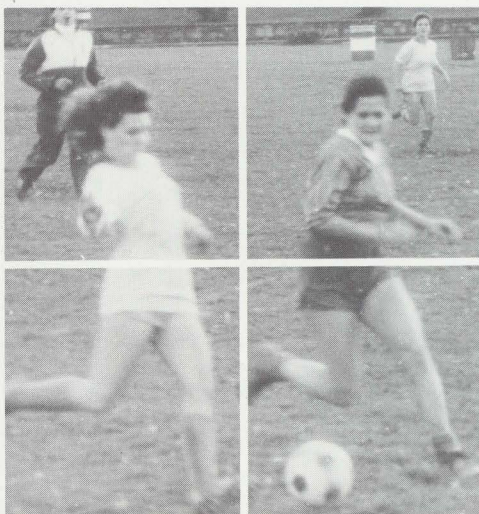




SOCCER

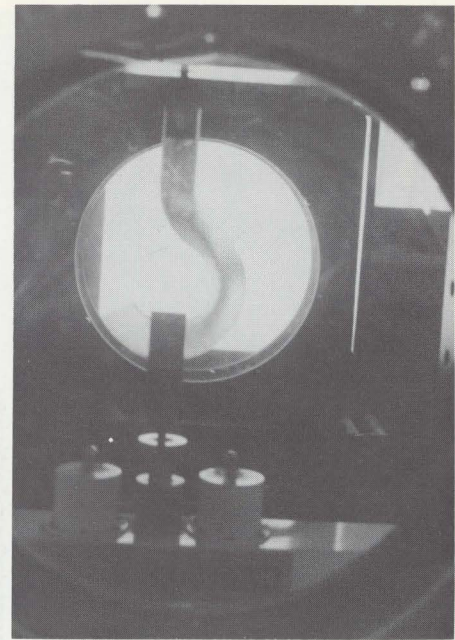
Congratulations to each of you. You have come a long way, but this is just the beginning. I wish you success in your careers and in all your endeavours in the years ahead.

And I have always felt that in the School we deal no less with reality than we do in the world outside the School. In the School we must deal with more profound and principal aspects of reality; aspects which provide an underlying structure for dealing with the detailed reality outside and to enable the student to maintain a clear sense of purpose and direction through the drift of daily life.

I hope that your education has to some extent enabled you to achieve this aim. And I hope that the infinite richness of the real world will always enrich your work with a sense of history, humanity, and humor.
