Topic: Recommendations to the Board of Directors concerning the reorganization of the structure and status of general membership and Board of Directors of Eye Level Gallery.

The following points were brought forward at this meeting to be ratified at the next membership meeting on January 22, at 7:30 P.M.

1. MEMBERSHIP FEES;
 - a. Participating... \$5.00 Commitment of not less than 30 hr. per year to the Gallery.
 - b. Active \$10.00 Commitment of not less than 10 hr. per year to the Gallery.
 - c. Sustaining \$25.00 Commitment of time not necessary.

* Members may be artists or non-artists Fees become due at the end
* Membership not necessary to show at Gallery. of each fiscal year
2. BOARD OF DIRECTORS;
 - a. A group of not less than five nor more than fifteen.
 - b. To be opened to both artists and non-artists.
 - c. To be chosen by the board of directors. *COLENTOR*
 - d. One member to be responsible (with the Coordinator) for at least one show per year at the Gallery.
 - e. Must commit not less than six months to the board.
 - f. Maintain a majority of artists as members on the board.
 - g. Must have a vote of 60% of total board members in favor of a motion to carry it.
 - h. To have a minimum of one meeting per month.
 - i. To have a minimum of two meetings per with the general members.

One member of Board appointed to attend the general members meetings and one member of general membership to attend Board meetings.
