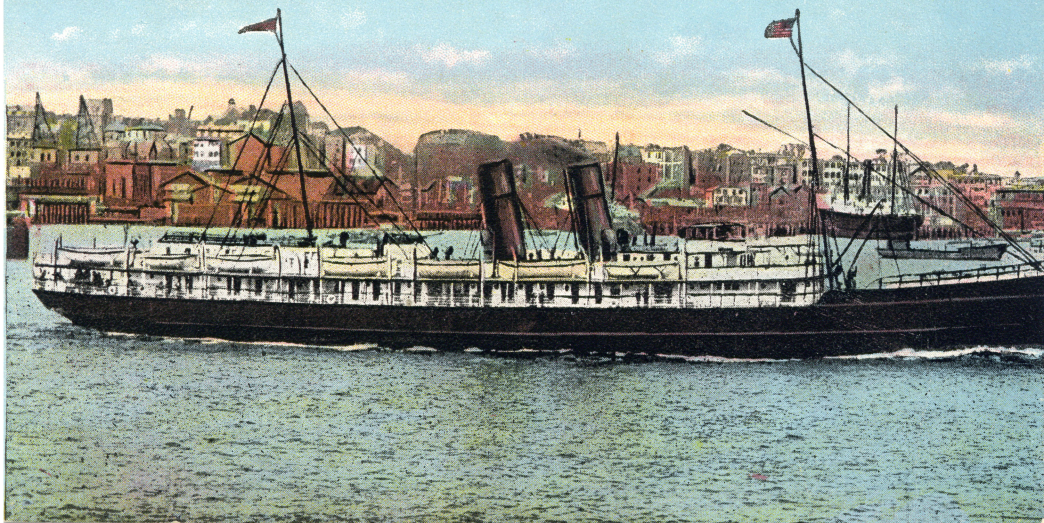


S. S. PRINCE GEORGE, YARMOUTH, N. S.
