Owen Seal came to Pleasantfield in
1898. At that time all the old buildings
at Indian Gardens had vanished.

Harlow & Kempton had a barn or storehouse
built on the west side between 1900 and 1910.

Eva Knauth (who later married Fred Patch)
knew the Staymers, visited them. She got a
drive to Pleasantfield, hired Ezekiel Sanders to
guide her to Indian Gardens. At that time the Indian
Gardens Road took a wide loop, almost to George's
Lake, & it was a long way. They were overtaken
by night & spent the night together in a shack.

Richard Lelper lumbered at Indian Gardens when young. Went to Hales & worked for years. Then returned & decided to farm at Indian Gardens; this was in the early 1900's. His family lived in Millon, though he was born in North Queens. He just spent the summers alone at the Gardens with his horse & dog.
