DIRECTOR'S

MESSAGE

On behalf of the Faculty and Staff of the College of Pharmacy, I am pleased to have the opportunity to extend our warmest congratulations to the Class of 2007.

It is hard to believe it was just four years ago that you entered the College of Pharmacy and now it is time for you to move on to the challenges of your new careers in pharmacy or to continue on with your education. The past four years have been an exciting time in the Colleges history. This year, The Dalhousie Student Pharmacy Society (DSPS) won the A-level Student Society of the Year Award, sponsored by the Dalhousie Student Union. This is the second time in four years the DSPS has received this award. It was wonderful to see the establishment of the Dalhousie Pharmacy Student Endowment Award. The leadership of your graduating class, DSPS and CAPSI in establishing this fund for future students is commendable.

These are also exciting times for our chosen profession of pharmacy. The Canadian Pharmacists Association (CPhA) recently led a Blueprint for Pharmacy calling pharmacists to shift more attention to patient-centered, outcome-focused care. CPhA also provided us with key actions in order to realize this vision. Legislative changes are occurring in some provinces to support various forms of prescriptive authority. The role of our technicians will soon be changing. Many of our licensing bodies are looking at incorporating technicians under their Acts along with the pharmacists. Our accreditation body, CCAPP (Canadian Council for Accreditation of Pharmacy Programs), will be accrediting technician programs as soon as 2008. The scope of practice for pharmacists continues to expand and pharmacists are finding new roles within primary health care reform. Patient safety is still one of the hottest topics in health care and pharmacists in both community and hospital settings are taking leading roles to improve the medication use system. Hospital Accreditation will be requiring all hospitals to have a plan within the next three years to implement medication reconciliation for all patients.

Our profession is not without it own challenges: the outdated payment schemes that focus on dispensing fees rather than service, our lack of access to patient information, and the debate over the educational requirements for entry to practice in Canada continues. Change will not occur immediately but we are on the right path.

I am confident that as graduates of the Dalhousie College of Pharmacy, you are equipped with the skills needed to meet any of these challenges and to take advantage of every opportunity. Be sure to become involved and help with the necessary changes to move our profession forward.

Congratulations and best wishes for the years ahead. Please be sure to keep in touch.
