My Dear little sister

Your most loving and welcome
letters rec'd yesterday and I was so
glad to hear from home again. I just
came back of my six day leave and
am feeling O H was awful sorry when
I had to leave Aberdeen Scotland
I had a lovely time yet the people are
just great they can't do enough for
the Canadian soldiers much better
than in England people are very good
there to be in so nice as Scotland
every person has a smile to greet the
Boys I wrote Mother and Lillian
last evening and sent some postal
cards that is views of different parts
of Scotland and London yet I do

believe that you would get lost in
 London it is twenty five miles square.
 Some Beautiful Buildings; Saw
 Buckingham Palace that is
 where the King lives and West Minster
 Abby that is a grand place to see
 you have often read about it at home
 was all through the Tower of London
 was in the dark dungeon and the
 Chapel was thirty Eight Hundred
 and fifty years old very nearly as
 old as I am ~~that~~ Walked across
 London Bridges and all these places
 O I had a dandy time we are going
 to the drill now I can tell you how
 we had a good rest and can stand
 some work I would like to have seen
 Florence Jew that is one of the
 question altogether I suppose that

you all success and try and work
hard like a good little girl really
yes I say of yours and Lillias

write so often I shall never forget
you believe me and Mother and
Lloyd I say their letter like wise
but I think that Lloyd is a bit

as often as I write you girls and
Mother but then I suppose that
he is being working hard all day
and does not feel much like writing
evenings or I do say of Mother's
letters she always tells me all
