My Dear Sister

loving letter. I sure did enjoy your letter
and you did write me a long and eight
pages I read three in the one evening
and from your Lord of Lillies to your
see I had a good evening reading I have
been drilling all day and am feeling
just a little bit tired here I am feeling
great every other way. I wrote brother
a big long letter Sunday and one to

Lillias I doyd² Yesterday so I will be
finishing up with you for this week I
did not receive Brochers letter yet but will
be getting it soon and that Paul well
I did enjoy the contents just a little
tho I was almost sick when I first
tasted it and so the gardens are
fine are they well I can picture you all
walking around and looking at them
Beautiful flowers they have some very
pretty gardens over here but really they
are not any prettier flowers but of course
the scenery is much different here and

You asked me if that was the size of
 that Park an that Pastal that I sent
 You so Distur that Park would hold very
 ready all to alibe I mean the Population
 and it is a very pretty place they have
 Glass houses and hot houses that you
 can walk through I tell you it is worth
 seeing and all them Building yes they
 are certainly nice I often wished for you
 all to be able to see the different Parts
 that I have seen of course that is not
 very much but still it is worth seeing now
 I suppose that you all have very photos
 by this time some laughing you will

do as by your ^{letter} says so you think that I
have a Bald Bissuit Well I can did
laugh when I read that it did sound
odd & told Chadr about it and we
laughed to kill our selves for my hair
has grown out and have had to cut
several times since and now I like
it cut just so & do not pay any attention
to these fellows over here about having a
Bald cut of course & had to have it
cut the first time you pin your eye I do not
see very much improvement in your writing
and by that I do not believe that you
are doing very much learning that is

 sure that Jan will be very some day
 if Jan don't try and pay more strict
 attention to learning you really sister I
 do not want to be writing to Jan like
 this but I do feel it my duty to give you

 thro- and now I see Jan mistake by not

 be getting quite cold in N. & now October
 is always a cold Wet month the weather
 is terrible changeable over here raining one
 day and fine the next Charles recd some
 letters from Calif. and he seemed very
 much pleased so I guess they must have
 been from Winder & he is the same
 old fellow just as little as ever now just
 I think that I have told you very nearly
 all the news for this time there is nothing
 strange around here just the same all

time come do go do - I suppose that you
 are having plenty of salt & berries and
 good potatoes but my heart sure does
 water when ever I think of good old salt
 & berries sure I am sure I come from
 the plenty that have been in the land since
 for about ten years and they call them
 fresh for much give my love to all
 and be a good little sister and put
 me plenty give my letter good night
 from your loving brother
