My Dear Sister

Your letters were id to day and O how glad I was to hear from you & come again really I am a new boy to night I was so happy that I could have almost done without my dinner just imagine ten letters and one Postal three letters from you two from Lillias one from Mother one from Lloyd one from Annie Bessie two from Mabel and one from Elsie Now I had some time reading and I sure did read some I tried to read them all at once it does seem so strange that Mother Letter and Lloyds were so late arriving but that is the way they go. Never can give any account for them I am awful sorry to hear that you have been sick since I left home I hope that you did not lose them pretty cheeks of yours I want to see them as Rosy as ever When I come home again you would laugh if you could see mine they are just as dark as can be from the heat I am over here drilling without a hat and it certainly does make a fellow laugh this Soldier life plenty of Drill and half enough to heat eyes really. I cannot explain just how happy I am this evening I just came of Parades dinner now feeling a little quite tired and the first thing that was passed to me was seven letters I almost jumped to hear of my Povers well that took my spare time reading them then this evening I recid that more we can't you just see me sitting on my Bunk reading my letters from dear old home O Working like a

every week from now on almost makes life seem worth living  
that was a very nice photo that Deabel sent to me how  
all that I want is photos of the family do not want  
about the camera getting broken just have some taken for  
me you do not have to look at them I will do that part  
myself. I shall try and have some taken and send them  
to come but then you all have some of me. I will have some  
taken just the same. I would dearly love to see Lloyd  
New suit on him I can see future him he has such a nice  
build for a suit to fit nice now I don't think that I shall  
write to Brooker & Lloyd this evening as I only wrote to  
them yesterday and so I haven't very much news to tell  
them until in a few days and then I shall write them  
no doubt that by this time you all have had several letters  
from me I am awful long to hear that Mrs & Cabb got with  
such a sad accident and then to lose his wife well  
that is to hard I think poor fellow really I pity him  
tell him for me that I feel very sorry for him also tell  
him that I shall write him soon he may not be at home  
for a time so it would be useless to write just now and  
so you were at home for a couple of days suppose that  
there are just as many rocks as ever yes I would give  
a lot to be able to take you to the theatre again I would  
appreciate it I can assure you and so I am so glad  
to hear from you your self that you will go to school



again I know how that you will go that you have  
told me your self really I get I would love to see you  
with a good Education you think how nice it will be.  
I am more then pleased to hear that Brooker has her  
teeth extracted she will feel much better with them  
out and then she will be able to get them awful fake ones  
they look nice and are better then nothing but give me  
the real ones for mine try and hold fast to yours  
you get that one fitted if you have not get the money from  
Brooker she will give you enough don't leave them go to  
for my teeth are going fast will have to get about  
three and soon now sister I think that I will bring this  
letter to a close for this time as I am going to write Lillian  
a few lines this evening be sure and write after and  
good long letters every letter means one pound of  
flour to me now be a good little girl for your Brother  
take that is for away and be good to Mother get you  
will only know what it is to have the love of a good Ma  
when you get separated from her don't cause her any worry if  
you can avoid it give my love to all and write soon
