1030 Commence route of March from Ball Park to Fort Point by way of Bristol Avenue, Bridge Street and Main Street.

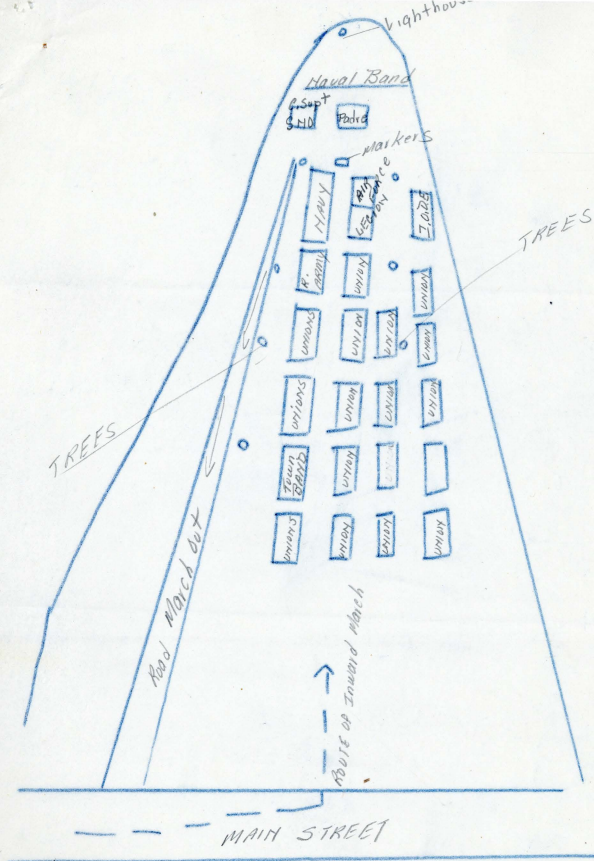
