Gentlemen:

Regarding my royalty statement for the six months ending Oct. 31, 1971.

I cannot understand the sudden appearance of an "unearned balance" of \$587.75, apparently on the U.S. account of "Path of Destiny".

My records show that I received \$4,000 from Toronto on March 18/55, and \$2,000 from Toronto on Feb. 3/56, making the total advance \$6,000 as agreed in the contract. Royalties credited to me to April 30, 1959, from U.S. and Canadian sales came to \$6,216.87, thus wiping out the \$6,000 advanced. My royalty statement from Toronto to the end of April, 1968 included a credit of \$900.00 from the Popular Library edition, less "unearned royalties on the U.S. first edition, \$151.02", making a net payment of \$748.98 to me.

Will you explain this, please.
