NEW ROLE FOR LEADING CANADIAN PUBLISHER

TORONTO (March 18, 1982) ... Following his announcement that Linda McKnight has been named President and Publisher of McClelland and Stewart Limited, Jack McClelland has outlined his own intention of pursuing special projects on behalf of the company. McClelland had held the title of President of the firm since 1959.

Jack McClelland was born in Toronto in 1922. He attended the Brown School and the University of Toronto Schools in the city, St. Andrews College in Aurora, and the University of Toronto. After serving with the Royal Canadian Navy during W.W. II, he retired with the rank of Lieutenant-Commander R.C.N.V.R., and returned to University of Toronto to receive a B.A. from Trinity College in 1946.

That same year, he joined McClelland and Stewart and worked his way from warehouse to office to sales department to acting general manager, before being appointed Executive Vice President and Managing Director of the company in 1951. In 1959 he was named President.

McClelland and Stewart was founded in 1906 by John McClelland, Jack McClelland's father, and was originally a library supply house. It began publishing its own books within a few years, and by the late twenties had become a major force in Canadian publishing. The author list at that time included such names as Ralph Connor, L.M. Montgomery, Marshall Saunders, Bliss Carman, Duncan Campbell-Scott, Stephen Leacock and H.A. Cody.



In 1958, McClelland and Stewart joined the paperback revolution with the first quality softcover series to appear in Canada, and during this period the company became established as the leading general publishing firm in Canada.

The current success of McClelland and Stewart is generally credited to the work done by Jack McClelland, and he has long been recognized as the leading figure in Canadian publishing. 
