 by my Honored Father Nathan Supper Esqr deceased
 in his Last Will and Testament and all other Estate
 that may or might fall to me as an Heir to said
 Estate not mentioned in said Last Will and Testament
 in the Township of Liverpool - (Excepting the
 undivided Lands mentioned in said Last Will and
 Testament to be Preferred) to him the said Nathan
 Supper his Heir and assigns for ever Reserve
 being had to the aforesaid Will for the
 Description of the abovesaid Estate &c.
 To Have and to Hold to him the said Nathan
 Supper his Heir and assigns for ever all the
 above granted and bargained premises free
 and clear from any Molestation or Lett whatsoever
 from me the said Mead Supper my Heirs Executors
 and Administrator claiming any Right Title
 or Interest in any of the above bargained
 premises or any part thereof
