I am pleased to advise you that the Readers' Club of Canada has offered to use "In My Time" as a selection in Canada this Summer. They will purchase approximately 1,500 to start, and will offer it to their members at our suggested list price of \$14.95.

This means that the total royalty income from Readers' Club of Canada can be expected to be \$1.495 per copy of which about .75¢ would be paid to you per clause 14(b) of our agreement. There would not be any advance. Instead the above would be paid to us on delivery of books and on re-orders.

These are the salient points. I consider it a very encouraging sale and one which may also stimulate bookstore sales, even though the income to you is modest.

According to the terms of our author contract may I have your written approval that we should proceed on this basis.

It was a great pleasure to talk to you the other day. As always it was good to hear your voice, but more important to know that you have made such a fine recovery and have even been back out on the golf course. Although we have never had a match, I have known for many years of the unorthodox (but effective) style with which you stunned the fellow members of your club.

It has taken us longer than I had anticipated to sort out our reprint program. I am not even sure that we have the right answer even yet. Our key decision, Tom, was to put the New Canadian Library into cold storage for a period of time, at least as far as new additions were concerned. This does not mean that the New Canadian Library is being discontinued. It simply means that we will not add additional titles for at least several years. Those already in the Series will be kept in print and be sold even more assiduously than before. The reason for the decision to stop expansion was my concern about the fact that too many of the new books were either weak contemporary novels or weak very early novels that were of only historical interest - or to put it differently - we became concerned about the weakening of the quality of the Series.

What to do in the meantime became the problem. After interminable discussion we decided to experiment with a new series of trade or what they call quality paperback. These will be substantially more expensive than the New Canadian Library (range \$4.95 to \$7.95). The books in this grouping may eventually be transferred to the New Canadian Library, but if they do well in the

trade paperback format, they will probably remain there. This series will simply be known as M&S paperbacks.

We would like to publish HANGMAN'S BEACH and the GOVERNOR'S LADY in this series in March of 1979. In doing so, we have two thoughts in mind. First we think there may be a substantial market in Canada for a uniform Raddall set. If these two titles work as well as we anticipate, we will add others and then re-issue those that are already in the NCL Series (although we will retain them in that series) and try to produce a uniform Raddell edition. Our initial publication will be in a quality paperback which is, of course, a larger format than the NCL. We will, with your books, probably experiment as well with hardbound editions because they have been unavailable for some time. I can't, for the moment, guarantee the hardbound editions immediately. Please accept it as a matter of intent for the moment.

If it is agreeable to you, I would propose to draw up contracts on the following terms:

1. Hardbound royalties would be 10%; 15% after 5,000 copies have been sold.
2. Paperback royalties would be 8% moving to 10% after 5,000 copies had been sold.
3. Book club rights and other volume rights or licences in Canada would be divided 60% to you, 40% to us.
4. We would handle all other rights, including foreign sales (by all other rights I mean television, radio, etc.) at a flat agent's fee of 10% although we would be prepared to leave these rights in your hands if that is more acceptable to you.
5. Because we are dealing with reprints and an unpredictable market at the moment, I would like to offer only a nominal advance against royalties of \$1,000.00 on each of the two titles. It is not a large sum of money, but if we are being unduly conservative, royalty payments

would pick up the slack very quickly.

It will be our intention to follow with two more titles - probably in the fall of 1979 - if this experiment is even mildly successful. Is the foregoing agreeable to you? If it is, I will have the contracts drawn up without delay. If it is not, do let me know the points you feel should be changed.


Dear Tom:



Dear Jack:

I found your letter awaiting me at Banff, and the duplicate lay in my post office box here when I got back. Thank you for your congratulations on receiving the University of Alberta medal.

I was unable to go to Banff to receive it last summer because of a second eye operation and its later complications. Indeed I was dubious about making such a long journey this year with my eyesight difficulties and my arthritic limp, but I'm glad I went.

The Banff Centre people were very hospitable and helpful, and I enjoyed joining in their writing seminar with Bill Mitchell. Comparing notes with Bill, I found that we both gave up steady jobs for the perilous chances of a free lance writer at about the same time. We were both resolved to stay in Canada and write entirely about Canada and Canadians, and to make a living at it we had to get into top American magazines, which we did. Unknown to each other, and three thousand miles or so apart, we lifted two corners of that false picture of Canadian life painted by novelists like James Oliver Curwood and the moving pictures -- a country usually under snow, and populated thinly by Red-coated mounties with grand baritone voices, pretty Indian maidens who could warble like birds, an Eskimo or two in the background, and for comic relief a French ragamuffin who spoke a very funny kind of English. In that respect Bill and I were pioneers.

The thick lenses of my new glasses oblige me to be careful in short-range matters like going up and down stairs. They are bi-focals and for a long time I was bothered with double vision when I tried to read. That has been straightened out, and at Banff I was delighted to find that I could see well at long distances.

I am able to drive my car locally as far as the golf course and my son's place at Hunt's Point, and I even play a weird travesty of golf for the sheer pleasure of movement in the sun and the sea air.

In short, I'm enjoying life again after three years of hell that began with E's death in 1975, and then the long miserable struggle with blindness.

With regard to Canadian paperback publication of the titles released by Doubleday, what's your proposition, Jack?

Sorry I couldn't stop over at Toronto on my way home from Banff. My return flights had been booked and confirmed long before, and I felt that I couldn't risk, in view of the heavy holiday traffic, and the slim chance of picking up a seat to Halifax.
