My dear Mr. Dobrynin:

First of all I want to express my sincere gratitude towards the Soviet leadership and all the organisations concerned for the opportunity to be among the participants of the International Forum "for a nuclear-free world, for the survival of humanity" held in Moscow on February 14-16 this year.

The Moscow forum was a most timely event for the benefit of all mankind. Its goals should be incorporated in the programme of all the democratic forces active in the world. The survival of humanity and the continued existence of civilisation on the planet must take priority over any other problem.

I am one of the leaders of the International Ocean Institute (IOI) founded in 1970 to promote research in the field of peaceful use and exploration of the Ocean and its resources as well as in the regulation of such activities. We would be most grateful for your kind consideration of this proposal, and if your reaction is positive, as we fervently hope, we would of course hope for your active cooperation in giving to this event the worldwide importance it should have.

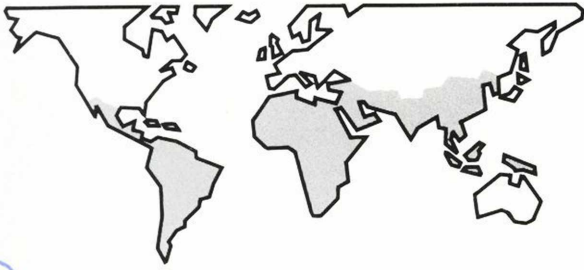

Perhaps you remember: we met at your headquarters when you received the Canadian Unesco Commission's Committee for the Cultural Decade, of which I am co-chairperson.

Today I would like, **very confidentially**, ask for your advice and, if possible, help in the following matter.

I have a colleague in Moscow, a member of the Planning Council of our International Ocean Institute, who is an outstanding international lawyer, President of the Soviet Maritime Law Association, representing the Soviet Union on many important international Fora, including the International Maritime Organisation and the Intergovernmental Oceanographic Commission of UNESCO.

He is Jewish. When I was in Moscow a couple of months ago, he confided me his great preoccupation with certain developments there, rampant nationalism, including antisemitism. He was concerned there might be pogroms any time. He and his wife would love to go abroad for one or two years to see how things are going.

Considering his extremely high qualifications, the Law School here at Dalhousie would be simply delighted to have him as a visiting professor for one or two years -- but, you know how it is with universities these days: there is no money! So: if a Foundation, and, of course, I am thinking first of all of a Jewish Foundation, could come up with a modest salary for 2 years, or one year, or, I imagine, even for six months! -- we could solve this problem.

Do you think your own Foundation could find a way of assisting? If not, could you give me an advice as to whom I might approach?

I would be most grateful.

My dear Anatoli,

This is to follow up on our recent all too brief phone conversation.

We are of course immensely happy that you will be with us at PIM XIX and at the Board/Council meeting. As a matter of fact, we need you for both events!

We are also immensely happy that you intend to present a paper. IOC activities are very important indeed in the global context: They deserve a special case study.

After extensive consultations between Rotterdam, Paris, and Halifax, I would now like to draw your special attention to the following points:

1. You will be speaking at the conclusive session, and we have to keep in mind some sensitivities. UNESCO and IOC are co-sponsors of the conference -- but so are UNCED and UNU -- the latter is, in fact, a major financial contributor. They might wonder why IOC is given special treatment! So, please, treat it as a case study: an example; refer also to UNU and the context of UNCED. That would help.

2. If possible, do not make the case study merely descriptive but point out the need for change as well. You might use the background paper as a checklist for the kind of change we would like to discuss: evolution from a coordinating to an operational role; change in the relationship with the other "ocean institutions":

Integration of policy making. Need for new sources of funding.

3. We are breaking our own rule for you: all sessions have a limit of three speakers, to leave time for discussion (you know how dissatisfied a participatory audience is when there is no time for discussion); so we would urge you to limit your oral presentation to 10 minutes or under no circumstances beyond 15! The written text, of course, can be longer, but please no longer than 7,500 words.

I hope you can agree with these points.

We are following the news about your country with intense interest and participation.

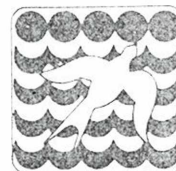

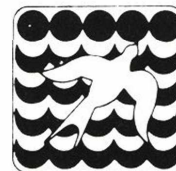
