Here is the brief history of Zion Church, as I promised. It took longer than I had expected, chiefly because I strive to be accurate, and such things as the origin and whereabouts of the first meeting house on King Street (supposedly Presbyterian) had to be tracked down.

I return herewith the typed notes of Mr. Wright. On the whole they were useful, though they have a number of inaccuracies; and I did not feel it necessary to copy the copious detail of the opening of the present church in 1866.
