

Leamington July 22nd 1917.

Dear Father.

Your letter of July 16th at hand. I saw Halle last night. The Jack screw you wanted is down to his place. He says he will send it to you if you want it. But thought that if you have decided to build here this fall, that you may not want it now. I will await further orders.

In regard to the Shipyard, He says that from the fact that he referred Mr Hatfield to you, should have been evidence enough that the Shipyard was entirely at your disposal. Mr Balcom telephoned me your message, that you were coming home this fall to build a vessel and that you were writing Halle. He had received no letter up to last night. He told me to tell you not to worry about him renting the yard, as it was not his to rent as long as you live.
