My Dear Sister

Just a few lines this afternoon to let you know that I am well here as you will see still at Rixensart however we are leaving Friday for France and will be in England by the last of the month this was our day to know but it was canceled and some around our head Quarters now I am not getting any mail from home lately suppose you are all expecting me home sooner than the last of May but will come myself lucky if we see home by then now I think that this will be my last letter from Rixensart and you will not see very many from Eng-

As we will be left quite busy and
 then signing papers and as I am
 not seeing anything concerning our discharge
 is made and in England and we
 don't have to sign any name about
 one thousand times but that is
 nothing so long as it is to get clear
 of this and fit for good we are having
 grand weather and fine and warm
 feels like summer by the way we
 are having our photos taken this
 afternoon the whole so it will be like
 you have home then I am at the 63
 only these will be Kelties I will
 try and get one for my self if
 possible suppose I am having

a good time now that the weather is
 getting warmer and that Easter
 Party, I'll bet you all had some
 time to it. I mean the one at
 East Dover. Wish that I could
 have been there to see James and
 Lillies for some eating can't you
 see (one ha he) Well you see
 just think you will be having
 your holidays a couple of
 weeks after I get home and
 then we will have a nice
 time all to ourselves. Some
 beds are at the inn then big
 baskets will suffer now I have a
 hunch that you all will

Waiting here and as I will not be
 looking for any more you should
 get this letter the middle of May
 and I will soon follow we are
 leaving here 25 three days from
 now to be a good little girl and
 give my love to all save one
 come see dream by by for this
