

This Indenture made the Twelfth Day of July in the year of our Lord One thousand Seven Hundred and fifty And in the Twenty fourth Year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord George the Second by the Grace of God of Great Britain France and Ireland King Defender of the Faith &c Between William Shirle of the Town of Halifax in the Province of Nova Scotia Taylor of the one part and Senachorib Martin of the said Town of Halifax Townshippers of the other part Witnesseth that the said William Shirle for and in consideration of the Sum of five shillings Sterling to him in hand paid by the said Senachorib Martin the receipt whereof is heretofore acknowledged and with the Consent and Approbation of the said Senachorib Martin the said William Shirle hath granted Bargained and Sold And by these presents Doth grant Bargain and Sell unto the said Senachorib Martin All that his one Moiety or half part of all the Lott of ground Number four Letter E: in Mr Luke Harmans Division And all Erections Edifices and Buildings on the said Moiety Erected and Built with all the Rights Members and Appurtenances to the said Moiety and premises belonging whatsoever which said Moiety or half part of the said Lott of ground Doth contain in Length or Depth from the front backward Sixty foot of assize or thereabouts little more or less and in width thereof continuing the whole Length Twenty foot of assize or thereabouts little more or less And About fronting Westward on a Street called or intended to be called Granvilles Street South on a Mesuage and Ground of Eastward the back part thereof on Ground of John Aubony Victualler and North on a Mesuage and Ground of the other Moiety of the said Lott And all Ways paths Waters Water courses lights easements Priviledges Profit Commodities and Advantages whatsoever to the said Moiety or half part of the said Lott belonging or in any wise Appertaining or which now are or formerly have been accepted reputed taken known used Occupied or Enjoyed to or with the same or as part parcel or Member thereof or of any part thereof And the Reversion and Reversions Remainder and remainders Right and Profits of the said Moiety and premises above mentioned and of every part and parcel thereof with the Appurtenances To Have and to Hold the said Moiety or half part of the said Lott and premises above mentioned and every part and parcel thereof with the Appurtenances unto the said Senachorib Martin his Executors Administrators and Assignes from the Day next before the Day of the Date hereof for and during and unto the full End and Term of one whole Year from thence next ensuing and fully to be Complisat and Ended Yielding and paying therefor One peppor Corn on the Feast of St Michael the Archangell (if Demanded) To the intent that by virtue of these presents and by force of the Statute for Transferring of Uses into possession the said Senachorib Martin may be in the actual possession of all and singular the said premises above mentioned with the Appurtenances and hereby be enabled to accept and take a Grant and Release of the Reversion and Inheritance thereof to him and his Heirs to the only proper Use and behoof of him the said Senachorib Martin and his Heirs and Assignes for ever In Witness whereof the said Parties have hereunto Interchangedly set their Hands and Seals the Day and Year first above written
