Since returning to the Bay Area I have been extremely busy working on various projects, but I did manage to discuss our conversation regarding OCEANS with the publisher, June Degnan and with Don Kelley, the editor. Apparently the IOI report was dropped from OCEANS sometime last year at the suggestion of Arthur Inman, the former publisher.
