I've often thought of you and our chat aboard "Toronto", not to mention the historic voyage in the Fairmile when I "represented" the august London Times.

Your address leads me to suppose you are now with your family, on leave, or perhaps out of the Navy. Or have they (God forbid !) made you an Ottawa admiral ? (I used to hear hard-bitten corvette skippers cussing orders from Ottawa where " the blooming woods are full of admirals".)

It seems strange here not to see a single naval uniform in the street, and corvettes (sold to private firms) lying at the dock without the traditional Christmas tree at the mest-head. The waterfront is littered with old life-rafts, Asdic cabins, crow's-nests, devits and what not, as a reminder of livelier days and a good companionship which we shall miss.

Thanks for your very kind invitation to tay with you if I should come to Ottawa. I shall certainly look you up if I'm in the capitel, but when that will be I don't know. I'm now deep in my new novel (to be published in the autumn of "46) and after that I've promised to do a book on Halifax which will require a lot of careful preparation.
