Dear Sir

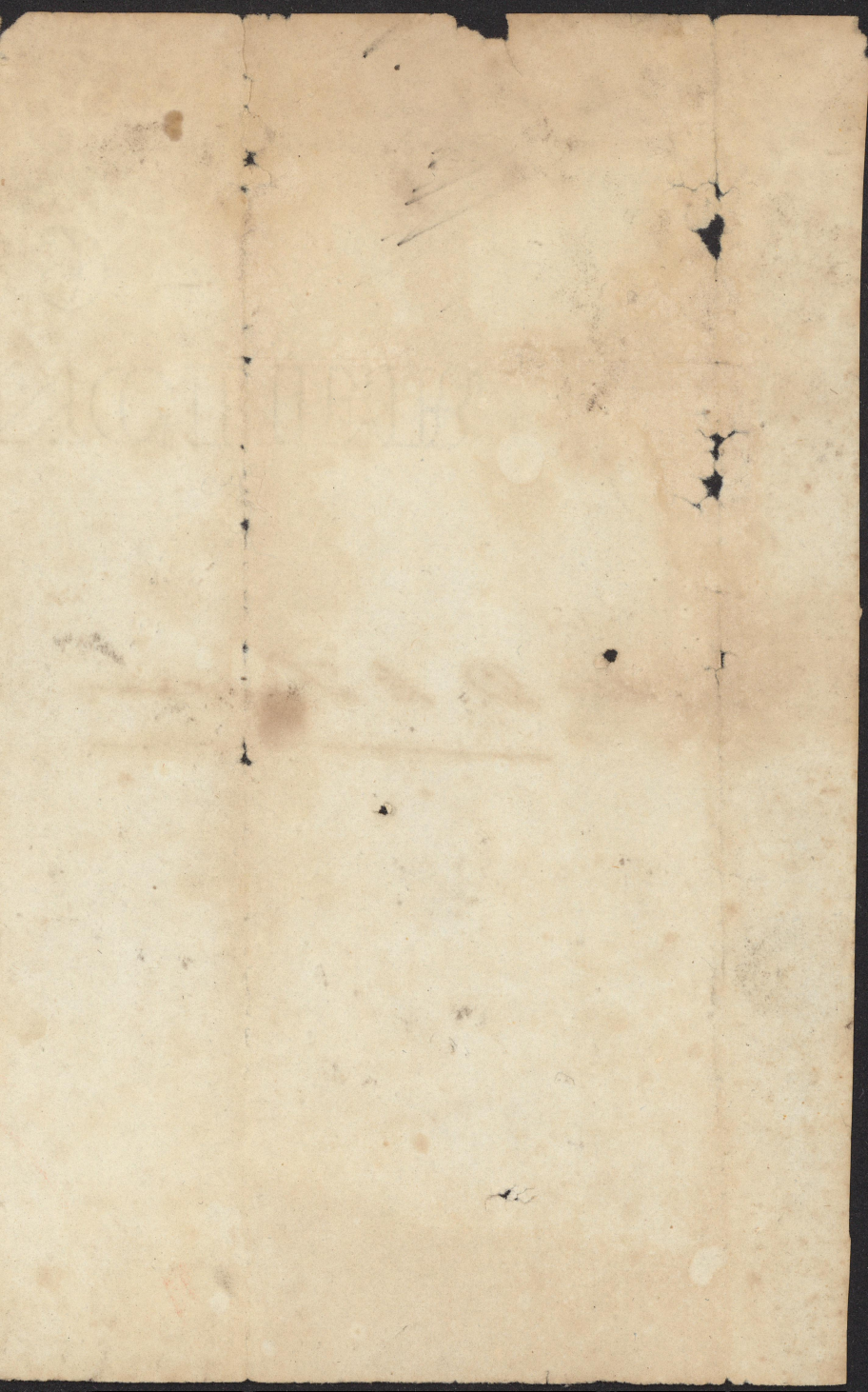
I am waiting on George

I made a rope fast to the  
25th when I was down last but I have  
not taken it up yet as we would see a  
great risk in having the machinery for  
if it was known we had got any thing  
up as there are a very great many  
I was in hope we will get it up tomorrow or possibly  
the looking only. Instead of 15 and 20  
as they require to work the most important  
like I only require one besides myself  
and I am in a short time do work  
then in working the best as I can  
myself with it. I explained the  
concern to Mr. Barker the other  
at before I commenced in making



me heard say that all  
cable and anchors in the  
harbours besides other property the name  
of Sir Warby was chains and anchors  
that were lost lately at public wharf  
between the break water wharf and here  
aboutly twenty upwards of \$100 a piece  
there is supposed to be a pound nine thou  
sand dollars yet where the Plumper  
was lost and there is only nine feet  
water at low tide if they had any luck  
at the time they might have got every  
thing I can see perfectly plain in show  
for all round me I shall write you again  
in a day or two as I fear Mr Hochstetel will be  
off
