

City staff are considering the feasibility of permitting parking on the centre boulevard area of University Avenue in the south end hospital complex.

City manager Byars made the comment in reply to a question from Ald. Fitzgerald at a safety committee meeting yesterday.

The alderman decried the lack of available parking in the hospital zone, and wondered if staff could prepare a plan for parking on the centre boulevard of University Avenue.

Mayor O'Brien noted that the city's parking advisory committee was also studying this proposal.

Ald. Fitzgerald said if parking meters were placed on the boulevard, revenues would pay for all installation costs involved.

Ald. Ivany said he knew of two proposals for parking garages in the area. One of them concerned a \$4,000,000 development on the east side of South Park Street near the school for the blind.
