THE FOLLOWING PROPOSAL FOR "PACAM IN MARIBUS XIII" IS SUBMITTED FOR YOUR CONSIDERATION.

1) CONFERENCE TOPIC

THE SUGGESTED TOPIC FOR THE CONFERENCE IS "TECHNOLOGY TRANSFER AND ~~MANAGERIAL~~ RESOURCES. TRAINING FOR MARINE RESOURCES DEVELOPMENT AND MANAGEMENT". THE PROGRAM SHOULD EXAMINE THE SKILLS AND TECHNOLOGIES REQUIRED BY DEVELOPING NATIONS IN MANAGING AND UTILIZING THE RESOURCES OF THEIR MARINE ECONOMIC ZONES, AND THE DEVELOPMENT OF TRAINING PROGRAMS TO PROMOTE TECHNOLOGICAL AND MANAGERIAL SELF SUFFICIENCY.

2) LOCATION:

IT IS PROPOSED THAT THE CONFERENCE BE HELD IN HALIFAX, NOVA SCOTIA, CANADA AT DALHOUSIE UNIVERSITY. CO-HOSTS OF THE CONFERENCE SHOULD BE THE I.O.F., THE CENTRE FOR FOREIGN POLICY STUDIES, AND, HOPEFULLY, THE INTERNATIONAL CENTRE FOR OCEAN DEVELOPMENT (ICOD).

1) CONFERENCE TOPIC: REGULATION AND CONTROL ON MILITARY USES OF THE SEA.

IT IS PROPOSED THAT THE PROGRAM BE ~~HELD~~ HELD AN ADVANCE OF THE RESIGNING OF THE SEA AND DISARMAMENT TREATY, AND THAT THE RESULTS OF THE CONFERENCE BE ~~USE~~ SUBMITTED TO THE TREATY COMMITTEE. THE CONFERENCE WILL EXAMINE THE CONFLICTS BETWEEN THE PEACEFUL USES OF THE SEA AND THE MILITARY REQUIREMENTS OF COASTAL STATES TO ENSURE ~~SEA~~ THEIR SECURITY.
