My Dear Sister

I am loving letter read and was so glad to hear from you again I wrote you last week just before I read your and Lillian's letter really you I haven't very much news to tell you as news is terrible from around here and I told you all pretty well about the leave I will soon be back and weeks of leave it does take very long to get back into the old life again was a bit sorry at first when I come back but soon got the better of that. We are doing very good with our diet and getting plenty of it believe me but then I suppose it is better to get plenty of it here than it is to go to the trenches with only half enough and we have to pay attention to it. I would like to see Uncle Sambo again here come talking he would do what is when he had the time to talk he would not find the time to talk now here that he had in Canada say when you write him from home again send him my address and tell him to write me we were always together down at the Island. I wonder if he has as much to say as ever and as you would like to pick Blue Bener would you I would like to be with you but I am afraid that I would not bring very many of game I would be like a stuffed rat by night if I had one day in the woods - you would have to carry me home that would be something you would do

I would like to have just one good pud of Blue
Berry Dumpling my Aunt it would be delicious believe me
I only had a few Black Berries to eat since I am
over here and they were gone now you I am sure
going to write very much to day really I do not feel
like writing I hope that you like your teacher this year
try and learn all that you can like a good little sister
I am expecting to hear from Aunt Addie soon as you
mentioned about her getting my letter the other and
write soon again and go after I told her I tell
him that I said he is to write after you my love to
all and give Mother a big kiss for me be a good.
